TO INITIAL DECISION OF ALJ

Protestant, Germantown Cab Company (“Germantown”), by and through its attorney, Michael S. Henry, Esquire, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.101, hereby objects preliminarily, to the reply of Danach, LLC (“Danach”), to the Exceptions of Germantown Cab Company to Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge, Christopher P. Pell (“ALJ”) for the following reasons:

1. On April 21, 2014, Danach filed a reply to exceptions of Germantown to the ALJ’s initial decision dismissing Germantown’s protest.
2. Preliminary objections are available under 52 Pa. Code §5.101.
3. Pursuant to the Secretarial Letter dated March 19, 2014, Germantown’s exceptions were due on April 8, 2014, and replies were due on April 18, 2014. A true and correct copy of the secretarial letter is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

4. Germantown timely filed its exceptions on April 8, 2014, as reflected on the attached dockets.

5. No replies were filed by April 18, 2014.

6. Accordingly, the reply filed by Danach on April 21, 2014 was untimely and was not filed in accordance with the Commission's regulations.

7. The Commission does not have jurisdiction to consider them.

WHEREFORE, Germantown respectfully requests that the reply to exceptions filed by Danach be stricken.
