The Commission is in receipt of the Objection you have filed to the Commission's General Assessment Invoice for FY 2007-2008. In that Objection, you have stated that your firm, Lanstar Inway, Inc., has registered under the Unified Carrier Registration Program for the year 2007 and should not have been assessed pursuant to Section 510 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 510 except for gross intrastate household goods revenues. After a review of your status as a UCR program participant, it is clear that you are UCR registered. No assessment is due except for any revenue on intrastate household goods moves.

You have indicated in your February 5, 2008, letter to the Commission that you inaccurately reported your gross revenue and that your gross intrastate household goods revenue was actually zero (0). Because the Commission's Assessment Report does not explicitly contain an entry for household goods revenue, the Commission will reduce your assessment to zero (0). If you have already paid your assessment under Section 510 of the Public Utility Code, those amounts will be refunded to you. The refund process takes approximately six weeks. If you have not already paid that assessment, there is nothing due and owing to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission on this invoice.

NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF PUC Truck OPERATING AUTHORITY Effective 05/01/2013 For expiration/cancellation of Liability

As of 05/01/2013, your PUC operating authority is **SUSPENDED** due to your failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file with this Commission. You may not operate while **under suspension.** Operating while under suspension is subject to prosecution, which may result in cancellation of your authority.

The Commission does permit electronic filing of these forms.

If this Commission does not receive acceptable evidence of insurance within ten (10) days of the suspension date, a Complaint will be instituted against you for failure to comply with this Commission's insurance requirements. The Complaint may result in the cancellation of your PUC operating authority.

If your insurer timely files appropriate evidence of insurance, you will receive Notice from the PUC authorizing you to resume operations. You may not resume operations until you receive this Notice from the Commission.
