

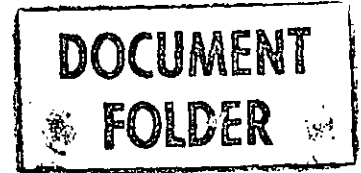

You are being granted an initial thirty (30) days in which to file the verified statement. The statement is due on or before March 18, 1985.

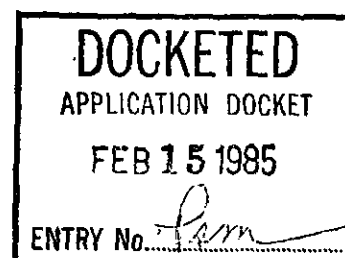
If additional time is required, it may be requested by telephone but should be followed in writing with the reasons for the extension stated.



VERIFIED STATEMENT OF APPLICANT

TO: PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION.

ROBERT MOLNAR, t/d/b/a ROBERT MOLNAR HAULING, pursuant to 52 Pennsylvania Code §3.381(e)(1) submits the following Verified Statement in support of its Application for issuance of a Contract Carrier Permit, and states as follows:

1. The legal name of the applicant is Robert Molnar, t/d/b/a Robert Molnar Hauling, whose domicile is Suttersville, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and whose mailing address is R. D. # 1, Box 38-A, Suttersville, Pennsylvania 15083.

2. This Verified Statement is being made by Robert Molnar, an individual over the age of 21 years, who trades and does business as Robert Molnar Hauling.

3. The applicant is not affiliated with any other common carriers or parties who have been issued a Permit as a Contract Carrier by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

4. Applicant seeks authority as a Contract Carrier to transport run of mine coal pursuant to a contract with Mikel Coal Company, of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, from that company's coal yard and loading facility at Smithton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, at the Smithton Exit of Interstate Highway #70, to Bentley Coal Company on U.S. Route #22, on Penn View Mountain near Blairsville, Pennsylvania, in the Townships of Burrell and West Wheatfield, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, a distance of approximately forty-one (41) miles along Highways U.S. Routes #119 and #22, and to Gallatin Fuel Company's coal processing facility located in Fallowfield Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania, near Speers, Pennsylvania, using Interstate Highway 70 from Smithton to Speers, Pennsylvania, a distance of approximately twelve (12) miles.

5. The applicant currently is not holding any certificate of public convenience or permit as a Contract Carrier issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

6. The applicant has no knowledge or information which would lead it to believe that the issuance of a permit to it as a Contract Carrier, authorizing it to undertake the fulfillment of its contract with Mikel Coal Company, would result in the duplication of any authority authorized to it or any third party by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

7. The applicant has no knowledge or information which would lead it to believe that the issuance of a permit to it as a Contract Carrier, authorizing it to undertake the fulfillment of its contract with Mikel Coal Company, would result in dual operations by applicant or any third party resulting from a grant of authority by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

8. The base of applicant's operations is R. D. # 1, Suttersville, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and communication is maintained by applicant through Citizens Band Radios in each truck and telephone.

9. The make, model and year of applicant's owned vehicles are as follows:

- (a) 1971 White, 4000 Triaxle Truck;
- (b) 1975 GMC, 9500 Triaxle Truck;
- (c) 1974 Mac R700 Tractor;
- (d) 1974 Penn Body 26 Foot Dump Trailer.

10. The safety program instituted by applicant includes the maintenance of a fire extinguisher and flares on each truck and requiring each driver to wear a hard hat and safety shoes, and to comply with the requirements of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the health and safety requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration and the Mine Safety and Health Administration of the United States Department of Labor, as applied to the applicant's proposed operations.

11. The applicant is not currently providing service to Mikel Coal Company, which is currently utilizing its own trucks for the transportation of its raw, run of mine coal. Applicant will commence rendering services pursuant to its contract upon the issuance of the Contract Carrier Permit, which application is sought.

12. The service to be rendered will be the transportation of raw, run of mine coal for Mikel Coal Company from its coal processing yard at Smithton, Pennsylvania to the points set forth in paragraph 4 above.

13. A current statement of assets and liabilities for Robert Molnar is set forth at paragraph 7 of its Application, which shows a net worth of \$236,700.00. Said statement of assets and liabilities and net worth of applicant is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

14. The return trips from Bentley Coal Company and Gallatin Fuel Company's coal processing facilities will be empty.

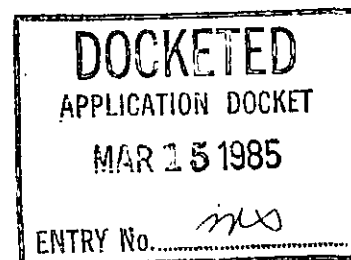
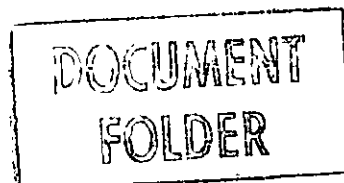
