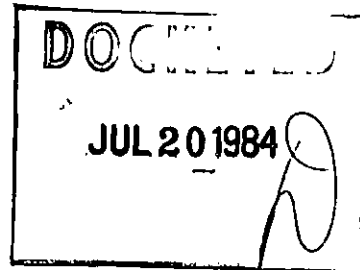

(a) Application of Harold E. Trego, Inc.

(b) Petition to Reinstate. The Commission cancelled the certificate of Harold E. Trego, Inc. on February 6, 1984 for failure to file its 1982 assessment report. Subsequently, a letter (petition) was filed by the carrier seeking to reinstate the certificate and alleging that the previous accountant stated that the forms had been filed. A review of the records reveals that certain Commission requirements for reinstatement have not been met.
