

**PREHEARING MEMORANDUM OF
COLUMBIA INDUSTRIAL INTERVENORS**

Pursuant to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Mark A. Hoyer's April 28, 2014, Prehearing Conference Order, Columbia Industrial Intervenors ("CII") hereby submit this Prehearing Memorandum in the above-captioned proceeding.

I. HISTORY OF THE PROCEEDING

On February 26, 2014, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia" or "Company"), filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or Commission") Supplement No. 210 to Tariff Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 ("Supplement No. 210"). Supplement No. 210 proposed a Pilot New Area Service ("NAS") offering an alternative approach to any residential applicant or bona fide developer who would be required to provide a deposit under Rule No. 8 – Extensions Rule of Columbia's tariff for an extension of the Company's distribution facilities.

On March 21, 2014, CII filed a Petition to Intervene in this proceeding. A description of CII is set forth in Paragraph 4 of CII's Petition to Intervene. CII's Petition to Intervene is pending and awaits disposition by the ALJ.

III. ANTICIPATED ISSUES AND SUB-ISSUES

As set forth in Supplement No. 210, Pilot Rider NAS would be applicable through Columbia's service territory "for any residential customer . . . or commercial and industrial customers" Because any changes to the Company's rates and terms of service may affect its members, CII is concerned that the Commission's resolution of these issues may significantly impact CII members' cost of doing business. CII anticipates pursuing these issues during this proceeding and reserves the right to raise further issues and to respond to all matters raised by other parties.

IV. PROPOSED WITNESSES

CII is in the process of evaluating whether it will sponsor testimony in this proceeding. In the event that CII decides to sponsor testimony, it will immediately inform the parties and the ALJ of any intended witnesses and topics of testimony. CII also intends to participate in this

proceeding through the submission of discovery, cross-examination of other parties' witnesses, and the submission of briefs, exceptions and reply exceptions, if necessary.

V. PROPOSED SCHEDULE AND DISCOVERY RULES


