
Applying for increases in hourly rates, increase in the Full Value Protection Service and adding over forty (40) mile line haul rates.

▲NOTE 1 - MINIMUM TRANSPORTATION CHARGES: Sundays and Holidays: 8 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2. Saturdays (any hour) or Weekdays (any hour): 2 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 3 and Columns 1 and 4.

▲NOTE 2 - Where service commences at the request of the shipper after 5:30pm, rates shall be on a time and one half basis as shown in Column 3.

NOTE 3 - Waiver of minimum charges - carrier convenience:

Carrier shall not assess a minimum charge (number of hours) whenever a move requires less than the minimum number of hours filed. And said move is performed solely at the carriers convenience. In such instances the carrier shall charge based on the actual time to complete move plus applicable travel charge.

NOTE AA - A flat charge based on one hour at the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, or 4 will be assessed to cover traveling charges to and from the job.

- ▲(d) \$1,000 deductible - \$1.00 per \$1,000

4. Full Value Protection will be provided by carrier if shipment is declared at a minimum lump sum of ◆\$10,000 in \$10,000 movements thereafter or \$6.00 for each pound of weight in the shipment, whichever is greater. Carrier will not offer Depreciated Valuation protection coverage.

**Rule 47 - Full Value Protection: (Tariff 51-W)**

The customer may elect to have Full Value Protection with deductible amount and charge as follows:

- ◆(a) Zero deductible - \$8.00 per \$1,000
- ◆(b) \$250 deductible - \$6.00 per \$1,000
- ◆(c) \$500 deductible - \$4.00 per \$1,000
- ▲(d) \$1,000 deductible - \$2.00 per \$1,000

4. Full Value Protection will be provided by carrier if shipment is declared at a minimum lump sum of ◆\$10,000 in \$10,000 movements thereafter or \$6.00 for each pound of weight in the shipment, whichever is greater. Carrier will not offer Depreciated Valuation protection coverage.


