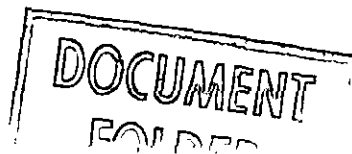

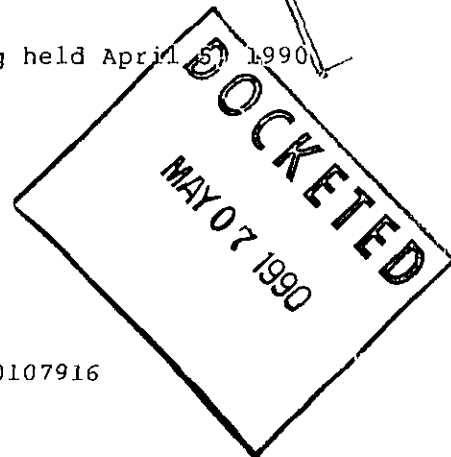

ORDER SUSPENDING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE

BY THE COMMISSION:

This Commission, as the duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, empowered to regulate common carriers and forwarders within this Commonwealth, represents as follows:

1. That respondent holds a certificate of public convenience issued by this Commission at Application Docket No. A-00107916.
2. That respondent is required by 66 Pa. C.S. §510, to pay to the Commission an amount reflecting respondent's proportionate share of the costs of administering the Public Utility Code. The assessment must be paid within thirty (30) days after receipt of notice of such assessment from the Commission, unless respondent has filed objections with the Commission as provided by 66 Pa. C.S. §510(c).
3. That on May 15, 1989, respondent was sent, by certified mail, Invoice No. 89-700340 in the amount of ninety-two dollars (\$92.00), the amount of respondent's assessment for the fiscal year July 1, 1989 to June 30, 1990. Respondent has not notified the Commission of any objections to the assessment.
4. That on August 31 and November 20, 1989, the Commission sent respondent past due notices. Accompanying the final delinquency notice was a letter from the Secretary of this Commission advising respondent that failure



to pay the general assessment in full within ten (10) days would result in the entry of an order suspending respondent's certificate of public convenience. To date, more than ten (10) days later, payment has not been received.

5. That respondent, in failing to pay its assessment, as described above, violated 66 Pa. C.S. §510, and is subject to suspension or revocation of its certificate of public convenience as provided by 66 Pa. C.S. §510(c); suspension or revocation of vehicle registrations, as well as remaining liable for the amount lawfully assessed and the cost of collection incurred by the Commission or the Office of the Attorney General; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of public convenience issued to respondent at Application Docket No. A-00107916 is hereby suspended upon service of this order, and all rights, powers and privileges granted thereunder are suspended until full payment of respondent's assessment is received by this Commission.

2. That respondent may elect to, within thirty (30) days of service of this order, pay the full assessment due the Commission, by certified check or money order payable to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Upon receipt by the Commission of the check or money order, this order will be discharged without further proceedings.

3. That if respondent fails to pay the full assessment due within the thirty (30) day period, the Commission will enter an order cancelling respondent's certificate of public convenience and direct the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to suspend respondent's vehicle registrations.

4. That after a certificate of public convenience is cancelled, reinstatement will only be considered by the Commission, upon petition, for good cause.
