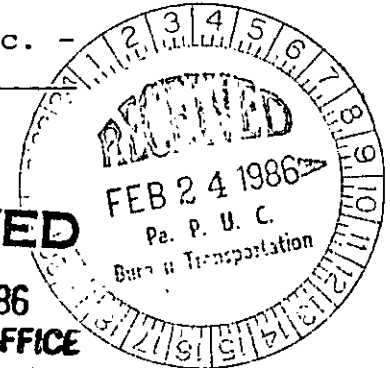

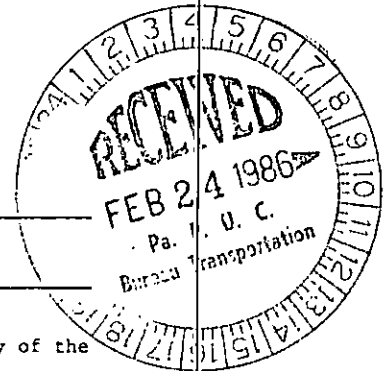

SALES AGREEMENT

Made this 10th day of February, 1986, between William J. Klein (hereinafter "Seller") and Klein's Bus Service, Inc. of Douglasville, Pennsylvania (hereinafter "Buyer").

1. Seller holds Pennsylvania intrastate motor carrier operating rights issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at Docket No. A.100442. All of said authority is incorporated herein by reference, and made an integral part hereof.

2. Seller agrees to sell and Buyer agrees to purchase all of the rights of Seller. It is the intention of the parties to transfer all of the operating rights to the corporation.

3. The purchase price for said operating rights shall be \$1.00, payable in cash at the time of consummation of this transaction, which requires prior approval by the Commission. Seller fully understands and agrees that the requisite approval by the Commission shall be unqualified and the operating rights to be transferred shall be no less than those set forth at A.100442. Otherwise, this agreement shall immediately become null, void and of no effect.

4. Seller warrants that said operating authority shall be free and clear of all liens, encumbrances, claims and adversary attacks of any nature whatsoever at the time of consummation.



7. This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their personal representatives, successors and assigns.


