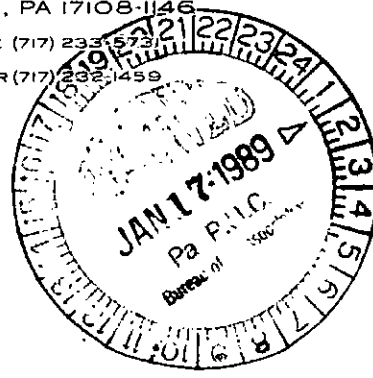

2. The original application signed at the place designated, duly verified by affidavit and two copies of same must be filed at the office of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P. O. Box 3265, North Office Building, Harrisburg, Pa. 17120. A filing fee of One Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$125.00) is required and shall be paid by certified check or money order, made payable to the **Commonwealth of Pennsylvania**.
3. It is not required that applicant be represented by an attorney to file the application. However, a corporation must be represented by an attorney at a hearing.
4. Copies of trade name registration form, certificate of incorporation or authority and statement of corporate charter purpose are not required from currently certificated/ permitted PUC carriers.
5. If space provided in form is not sufficient, prepare on separate sheet, attach it to application and give it the same number as question or statement to which it refers.
