(b) Broadway Moving & Storage, Inc. (carrier) of Trenton, New Jersey furnishes household goods in use services originating in Bucks County as more thoroughly described in the order which grants authority at Docket No. A-00106599. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Revised Page 23-D of Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 54 was filed on April 27, 2006. Carrier proposes to increase its hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 18%. **ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

Broadway Moving & Storage, Inc. (carrier) furnishes household goods in use services originating in Bucks County as more thoroughly described in the order which grants authority at Docket No. A-00106599.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Revised Page 23-D of Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 54 was filed on April 27, 2006. Carrier proposes to increase its hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 18%. Carrier currently charges \$110 per hour and proposes an increase to \$130 per hour (18%).

Carrier has submitted a tariff and documentation, in compliance with 52 Pa. Code §23.67(c), for carriers of household goods in use, with gross annual intrastate revenues of less than \$200,000. Currently, the carrier has no outstanding fines or assessments.

Carrier requests that the revised tariff becomes effective June 5, 2006. The current rates have been in effect since October 27, 2000.

**ANALYSIS**

In order to generate this revenue increase, Carrier proposes to increase its hourly rates and accessorial charges. Carrier proposes to increase its 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge of \$110 per hour to \$130 per hour, which would be an increase of 18%.

There are currently no outstanding fines or assessments.

The Carrier has provided a statement verifying that its revenues are under \$200,000 and its operating ratio is not less than 93%. Commission records indicate that the Carrier's total intrastate revenue is less than \$200,000 based upon assessment reports. We conclude that the data compiled and submitted by the carrier supports this increase.


**CONCLUSION**

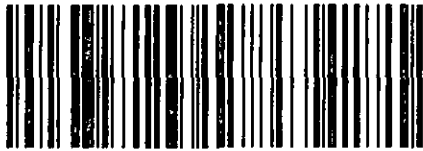
