Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Enclosed herewith are three (3) copies of Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 3 cancelling Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 issued by Isaac's Relocation Service, Inc. at A-00110007, and sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law.

Two (2) copies should be forwarded to Mr. Robert Bingaman, Compliance Manager of the Bureau of Technical Utility Services and one (1) copy to the Secretary's staff for scanning and information.

The proposed Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 3 lists selective increases in Item 100 Packing Container Charges. Item 300 increases the hourly rates for the transportation of household goods in use transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

Also attached is a signed letter that its 2013 Pa. Gross revenues were less than \$500,000 and its operating ratio was not less than 93%. The company's accountant submitted the 2013 Assessment report reflecting Pa. net intrastate operating revenue of \$544,239. The error of the report that the distribution of office moving was not properly shown under "property" and not household goods. The office moving revenue amounted to \$56,007. The household goods revenue should have been stated as \$488,232. The Bureau of Transportation and Safety and now the Bureau of Technical Utility Services continue to accept property revenue as not part of the gross Pa. revenues inasmuch as there are no regulations pertaining to rate filings for transportation service under the category of "property".



- (1) To transport, household goods in use, between points in the city and county of Philadelphia, and from points in said city and county, to points within ten (10) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of the said city and county, and vice versa.
- (2) To transport, property, excluding household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania.

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SECTION 1
RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory), loose-leaf revisions there-to and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 Shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property; except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE (A)

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by the shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see provisions contained herein or Governing Tariff, and provisions contained herein.

ITEM 40 - PACKING AND UNPACKING

Packing and unpacking will be performed on an hourly basis plus the cost of containers (Item 100) as shown in Section 3, Item 300.

ITEM 50 - Full Valuation Protection ●

The value you declare on your shipment must be at least equal to the weight of your shipment multiplied by \$4.00 per pound, subject to a minimum declaration of (R) \$5,000.00. For example, if your shipment weighs 5,000 pounds, the minimum value that you must declare is \$20,000.00. You can also choose a higher lump sum amount based on your estimate of what it would cost to replace all of your shipment.

SECTION 3
HOURLY RATES

ITEM 300

Applicable on the transportation of CLASS 1 SHIPMENTS (Item 20) transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Note 1 to 7 below, the transportation charge on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continued during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

- Note 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, 4, and 5).
- Note 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, 4 and 5) are based on the day or days, or periods of days, as indicated during which services are performed.
- Note 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, 4 and 5) computed in quarter-hour periods; fractions of one-quarter hour considered one-quarter hour.
- Note 4 - Minimum transportation charges: Monday thru Sunday - two (2) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2, 3, 4 or 5.
- Note 5 - Rates named in Columns 2, 4 and 5 apply only to 12:00 midnight. After midnight, rates for the next day are applicable.
- Note 6 - Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor or supervisors as requested by shipper. Hourly rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal of supervisor is provided by agreement between shipper and carrier.
- Note 7 - A flat charge based on one (1) hour at the applicable transportation rate shown in Columns 2, 3, 4 or 5 will be assessed to cover traveling charges to and from the job.

*Applicable on 20 ft. truck. • Add \$20.00 per hour when carrier provides to shipper 24 ft. or greater. (A) Add \$40.00 per hour when carrier provides to shipper tractor-semi trailer.
