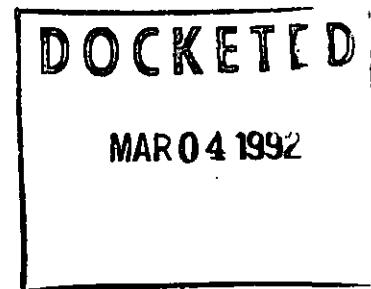
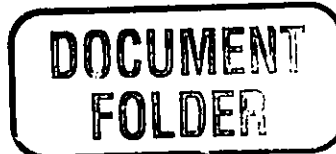
Enclosed, herewith, is Supplemental Order Cancelling Contract Carrier Permit issued by the Commission at public meeting.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER CANCELLING
CONTRACT CARRIER PERMITS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By an application filed on December 6, 1989, docketed at A-00108100, F. 4, Edward R. Rathway Trucking, Inc., seeks to have all of the common carrier rights held by Anne Louise Rathway, t/d/b/a A.L.R. Trucking at A-00105382 transferred to it, and to convert the contract carrier permits it now holds at A-00108100, Folders 1 and 2, and one pending at A-00108100, Folder 3, to a common carrier certificate.

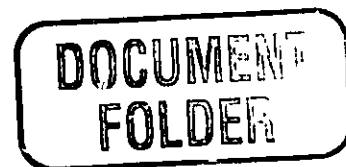
We find it in the public interest to convert the contract carrier authority now held by Edward R. Rathway Trucking, Inc., to common carrier authority in order to eliminate dual operations by a single carrier in keeping with the provisions at Title 66, C.S. §2504; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That upon compliance with the conditions and requirements as set forth in the order at A-00108100, F. 4, all the operating rights and the contract carrier permits held at A-00108100, Folders 1 and 2, and a pending permit at A-00108100, Folder 3, be and are hereby cancelled, and all rights, powers and privileges granted thereby shall forthwith cease and terminate.
