Gentlemen:

On May 17, 1996 and May 24, 1996, a Household Mover Review was conducted by Enforcement Officer William Lark of our Philadelphia District Office. The household moves which were reviewed took place between the dates of May 6, 1996 and May 22, 1996.

A review of your records disclosed the following violations:

1. In the household moves made for Lee Steele on May 8, 1996, Mr. and Mrs. Krikorian on May 10, 1996, William Bryon on May 14, 1996, Ruth Yaskin on May 15, 1996, Debbie Gillespie on May 17, 1996, Michelle Barakat on May 17, 1996, and Dr. Isaac S. Pike, 3rd on May 22, 1996, you failed to provide shipper and/or maintain a copy of written estimate, as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.122(1)(2). Also, without a written estimate, it cannot be determined if charges exceed estimate by more than ten (10) percent.
2. In the household moves made for Mr. and Mrs. Robert Norton on May 6, 1996, Mr. Krikorian on May 10, 1996, Harold Myer on May 13, 1996, and William Bryon on May 14, 1996, you operated beyond the scope of your authority. The transportation provided in these moves was to or from a different territory than that authorized by your certificate of public convenience. This is a violation of 66 Pa. C.S. §1102(a)(1)(i).
3. In the household move made for Debbie Gillespie on May 17, 1996, you charged a lesser rate than that specified in your Officially Filed Tariff. Note 7 states that a flat one (1) hour travel charge will be assessed at the applicable hourly rate. The traveling charge was \$41.00 as opposed to the proper rate of \$82.00. This is a violation of 66 Pa. C.S. §1303.

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

This letter is in response to your letter dated October 7, 1996, wherein you requested amendment to your existing common carrier household goods authority to include the right to transport property between points in Pennsylvania, excluding household goods in use.

The current authority held by Heritage Moving Systems, Inc., t/d/b/a Winters Movers includes, inter alia, the right to transport household goods and office furniture in use from points in the city of Philadelphia to points within 20 miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of the said city, and vice versa. The Commission's Final Decision on Regulation of Motor Common Carriers of Property at P-00940884, which was adopted December 15, 1995, entered December 20, 1995, adopted the Interstate Commerce Commission's definition of household goods which contains three provisos. The I.C.C. Termination Act of 1995 eliminated the second and third provisos from the household goods definition. The second and third provisos have now become a part of the property definition so that any household goods carrier holding household goods authority as of January 1, 1996, also now holds authority to transport property between points in Pennsylvania excluding household goods in use except as already authorized.

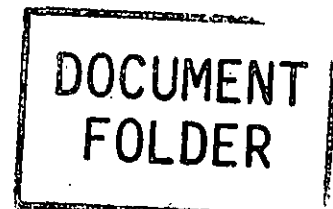
We require no further filings from you at this time. Your insurance currently on file meets our requirements for both the transportation of household goods in use and the transportation of property.


