Kathleen Harris v. IDT Energy, Inc., PA PUC Docket No. C-2013-2347594

Formal complaint filed at the PA PUC against IDT Energy, Inc. by a customer who claimed that her electric bills were too high. IDT filed an answer to the complaint explaining that the large past-due balance appearing on the customer's account was actually accrued by the customer when she was with the utility, prior to her enrollment with IDT and thus had nothing to do with IDT's supply service. The case was settled between the parties and a Certificate of Satisfaction was filed on June 10, 2013.

Warren Bray v. IDT Energy, Inc., PA PUC Docket No. F-2013-2373176

Formal complaint filed at the PA PUC against IDT Energy, Inc by customer regarding alleged incorrect charges for electric service. The case was settled and a certificate of satisfaction was filed on July 23, 2013.

The remainder of the customer formal complaints listed on Exhibit 3 are related to pricing issues caused by the Polar Vortex of 2014. As reflected on Exhibit 3, IDT Energy has satisfied nearly all of the formal complaints, with the exception of three complaints that are currently in mediation

<u>Pennsylvania PUC Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement v. IDT Energy, Inc.</u>, PA PUC Docket No. M-2013-2314312

This matter involved an informal investigation by the PAPUC's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) into informal customer complaints to the PAPUC's Bureau of Consumer Services regarding marketing contacts initiated by IDT's independent, third-party sales agents.

IDT fully cooperated with I&E throughout the course of the investigation, and the parties reached a settlement of the investigation without any findings of a violation by IDT. The Settlement was approved by the Commission by Order entered on October 17, 2013. The Settlement required IDT to pay a civil penalty of \$39,000 and to comply with additional reporting requirements and compliance actions as detailed in the Agreement.





You will continue to receive your bill from your Natural Gas Distribution Company (NGDC) for all supply and delivery charges, your NGDC will continue to provide all emergency repairs and services.

Right of Rescission - You may cancel this agreement at any time before midnight of the fifth business day after receiving this disclosure.

Definitions Generation Interstate Pipeline Charges-Charges for moving natural gas to the distribution lines of a distribution company, Commodity Charges- The charges for the natural gas product which is sold either in cubic feet or dekatherms, and Distribution Charges- The charge for the delivery of natural gas from the city gate to the consumer.

Basic Service Prices -Residents offers a variable price for all natural gas sold under this Agreement. The price for natural gas sold is established on an approximately monthly basis based upon natural gas market pricing, transportation or transmission, and other market and business price related factors. This price may be higher or lower than NGDC's price in any particular month. There is no ceiling price. Natural gas supply charges include estimated total state taxes. Residents will comply with all required laws regarding sales tax and will include or exclude the appropriate sales taxes in each jurisdiction served, if any, as required by the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue for all natural gas supply charges. Customers can call Residents Customer Service at 888-828-7374 for current variable pricing rates.

Payment Provisions- All payments are to be made to your NGDC. Any unpaid amounts shall be subject to late payment charges. Pursuant to 66 Pa. C. S. § 2208 (c), an applicant for a natural gas supplier license in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania must furnish security to each utility where the supplier will do business to ensure the financial responsibility of such natural gas supplier. To this end, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("National Fuel") has performed a credit review and analysis of Residents Energy, LLC ("RE") and has determined that RE must post a security deposit in cash, or a form of security acceptable to National Fuel, to operate as a supplier on National Fuel's system.

RE's security requirement to serve Pennsylvania customers is dependent on the type of transportation service utilized by RE. There is no Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) security requirement for customers that will be enrolled in National Fuel's Purchase of Receivable (POR) program. Summary of Technical Fitness

Residents Energy, LLC ("Residents Energy") is a wholly owned subsidiary of IDT Energy, Inc. ("IDT Energy") and will leverage the experience and resources of IDT Energy as it develops its brand. As an affiliate of IDT Energy, Residents Energy will utilize many of the same employees and third party vendors as IDT Energy. IDT Energy has been licensed as an NGS in Pennsylvania since 2009, an EGS in Pennsylvania since 2010, and is also licensed as a competitive gas and/or electricity supplier in New Jersey, New York, Maryland, Illinois and the District of Columbia. IDT Energy currently serves nearly 430,000 natural gas and electric meters in the states in which it is licensed.

Whereas IDT Energy primarily offers a pure variable rate product to customers on a month-tomonth basis, Residents initially intends to focus on offering residential and small commercial customers fixed rate contracts.

Residents Energy is dedicated to providing the very best in customer service and price and will strive to continually improve its ability to compete in the energy supply marketplace. To this end, Residents Energy has and will continue to develop a comprehensive process to identify and provide highly competitive products and services to its customer base, while maintaining profitability.

Residents Energy will leverage the IDT Energy in-house customer service staff to handle incoming customer calls. Additional staffing will be added as needed to accommodate growth. Residents Energy will utilize the ongoing training and support systems that IDTE has in place for handling incoming calls concerning bill inquiries, overpayment, complaints, and sign-ups. Residents Energy will also utilize IDT Energy's system of placing outbound calls for quality control.

Customer service will be handled mainly through a call center located in Jamestown, NY. The call center employs 42 inbound and outbound customer service representatives and supervisors and is staffed from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday with both English and Spanish-speaking representatives.
