





SPARACINO TRUCKING, dated April 21, 1970, for modification of the report and order issued under date of May 17, 1965 and the certificate of public convenience issued thereunder, and having been duly presented in accordance with the rules of the Commission, and full investigation of the matters and things involved having been had, and it appearing that the rights granted herein are in effect a transfer of the rights which have been held by MARY EVELYN KUPREVICH, trading and doing business as CLUNE TRANSFER, under report and order issued at A. 93242 on September 26, 1966 and the certificate of public convenience issued thereunder, which certificate will be subsequently cancelled, as of the date of this order, upon compliance with the tariff requirements of the Commission by JOSEPH N.
