


Please consider this letter as a petition seeking to permit transferee to retain the same P.U.C. number (Docket 92104) as currently assigned to transferor.

This proceeding basically involves the incorporation of a family owned business. Petitioner has conducted operations under the present P.U.C. number for approximately 23 years and wishes to retain the same number for its proposed corporate operation.

Petitioner's name and P.U.C. number are very well established with the shipping public in the Lackawanna and Luzerne County area, and assigning a new P.U.C. number may adversely affect future business. The current P.U.C. number is presently shown on freight bills, Bills of Lading, calling cards, painted on vehicles, etc., all of which will have to be changed if a new P.U.C. number is assigned.

For all intents and purposes the day to day operation of the business will be conducted the same as before except under a corporate structure.

Wherefore, for the reasons cited above, petitioner respectfully requests that the existing docket number 92104 be carried over and assigned to transferee.

A-00108084 JOSEPH SPARACINO MOVERS, INC. (No. 6 South Keyser Avenue, Taylor, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania 18517), a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania - as a Class B carrier, property between points in the city of Scranton, Lackawanna County, and within three (3) miles of the limits of said city; as a Class D carrier, household goods in use from points in the city of Scranton, Lackawanna County, to other points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa; subject to the following condition: That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport raw silk, materials and finished products of the silk industry; as a Class B carrier, property between points in the city of Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, and within an airline distance of three (3) statute miles of the said city limits; as a Class D carrier, household goods in use from points in the city of Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, and within an airline distance of three (3) statute miles of the said city limits to other points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa; and surplus food commodities for the Office of Public Assistance, Department of Public Welfare (formerly the Department of Public Assistance) from the warehouse in the city of Wilkes-Barre to points in the counties of Luzerne, Lackawanna, Bradford, Columbia, Lycoming, Schuylkill and Carbon, and vice versa; subject to the following condition: That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport raw silk materials and finished products to the silk industry, except that the applicant may carry silk and silk products to and from mills or other places of business and railroad stations, which is to be a transfer of the rights authorized under the certificate issued at A-00092104 to Joseph N. Sparacino, t/d/b/a Joseph N. Sparacino Trucking, subject to the same limitations and conditions.
