





- (2) The [natural gas distribution company] should likewise not apply a tariff provision in any manner that would give its affiliate or division an unreasonable preference over other marketers with regard to matters such as scheduling, balancing, transportation, storage, curtailment, capacity release and assignment, or nondelivery, and all other services provided to its affiliated suppliers.
- (3) If a tariff provision is mandatory, the [natural gas distribution company] should not waive the provision for its affiliate or division absent prior approval of the Commission.
- (4) If a tariff provision is not mandatory or provides for waivers, the [natural gas distribution company] should grant the waivers without preference to affiliates and divisions or non-affiliates.
- (5) The [natural gas distribution company] should maintain a chronological log of tariff provisions for which it has granted waivers. Entries should include the name of the party receiving the waiver, the date and time of the request, the specific tariff provision waived and the reason for the waiver. Any chronological log should be open for public inspection during normal business hours.
- (6) The [natural gas distribution company] should process requests for transportation promptly and in a nondiscriminatory fashion with respect to other requests received in the same or a similar period. The [natural gas distribution company] should maintain a chronological log showing the processing of requests for transportation services. Any chronological log should be open for public inspection during normal business hours.
- (7) Transportation discounts and fee waivers and rebates provided to the [natural gas distribution company's] or its marketing affiliate's favored customers should be offered to other similarly situated customers and should not be tied to any unrelated service, incentive

or offer on behalf of either the parent or affiliate. A chronological log should be maintained showing the date, party, time and rationale for the action. Any chronological log should be open for public inspection during normal business hours.

- (8) The [natural gas distribution company] should not disclose any customer proprietary information to its marketing affiliate or division, and to the extent that it does disclose customer information, it should contemporaneously provide this same information to other similarly situated marketers in a similar fashion so as not to selectively disclose, delay disclosure, or give itself or its affiliate any undue advantage related to the disclosure. A chronological log should be maintained showing the date, time and rationale for the disclosure. Any chronological log should be open for public inspection during normal business hours. A natural gas distribution company should not provide information received from non-affiliated customers or suppliers to its affiliated natural gas suppliers.
- (9) The [natural gas distribution company] should justly and reasonably allocate to its marketing affiliate or division the costs or expenses for general administration or support services.
- (10) The [natural gas distribution company] selling surplus gas supplies and/or upstream capacity on a short-term basis (as defined by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission) to its affiliate should make supplies available to similarly situated marketers on a nondiscriminatory basis. The [natural gas distribution company] should not make any gas supplies and/or upstream capacity available through private disclosure to the [natural gas distribution company's] affiliate unless the availability is made simultaneously with public dissemination in a manner that fairly apprises interested parties of the availability of the gas supplies and/or upstream capacity. The [natural gas distribution company] should maintain a chronological log of these public disseminations. Any chronological log should be open for public inspection during normal business hours.
- (11) The [natural gas distribution company] should not condition or tie agreements to release interstate pipeline capacity to any service in which the [natural gas distribution company] or affiliate is involved.
- (12) The [natural gas distribution company] should not directly or by implication . . . represent to any customer, supplier or third party that

an advantage may accrue to any party through use of the [natural gas distribution company's] affiliate or subsidiary.

- (13) The [natural gas distribution company] should establish and file with the Commission a complaint procedure for dealing with any alleged violations of any of the standards listed in paragraphs (1) through (12), this paragraph or paragraphs (14) and (15), excepting for paragraph (9), which should be exclusively under the purview of the Commission. *These procedures should be developed in consultation with interested parties during consideration of any tariff guided by this section and §69.191 (relating to general).* The Commission may expect establishment of a complaint procedure or other recordkeeping requirements if warranted by subsequent facts or circumstances.
- (14) The [natural gas distribution company] should keep a chronological log of any complaints, excepting paragraph (9), regarding discriminatory treatment of natural gas suppliers. This chronological log should include the date and nature of the complaint and the [natural gas distribution company's] resolution of it. *Any chronological log should be open for inspection during normal business hours.*
- (15) Parties alleging violations of these standards may pursue their allegations through the Commission's established complaint procedures. A complainant bears the burden of proof consistent with 66 Pa. C.S. (relating to Public Utility Code) in regard to the allegations.
- (16) Licensees shall provide accurate information about their natural gas supplier services using plain language and common terms. Where new terms are used, such terms must be defined again using plain language: Information should be provided in a format which will allow for comparison of the various natural gas supply services offered and the prices charged for each type of service.
- (17) Licensees shall provide notification of the change in conditions of service, intent to cease operation as a natural gas supplier, explanation of denial of service, proper handling of deposits and proper handling of complaints in accordance with Commission regulations where applicable.

- (18) Licensees shall maintain the confidentiality of customers' historic payment information and right of access to their own load and billing information.
- (19) Licensees shall not discriminate in the provision of natural gas supply services as to availability and terms of service based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex, marital status, age receipt of public assistance income, and exercise of rights under the Consumer Credit Protection Act, 15 U. S. C. §§1691-1691f; Regulation B, 12 C.F.R. §§202-202.14.
- (20) Licensees will be responsible for any fraudulent deceptive or other unlawful marketing or billing acts performed by their agents or representatives. Licensee shall inform consumers of state consumer protection laws that govern the cancellation or rescission of natural gas supply service contracts. 73 P. S. §201-7.
- (21) The natural gas distribution company shall not give any affiliate or marketing division preference over a non-traditional affiliate in the provision of goods and services such as processing requests for information, complaints and responses to service interruptions. The natural gas distribution company shall provide comparable treatment without regard to a customer's chosen natural gas supplier.
- (22) No transaction between the natural gas distribution company and an affiliated natural gas supplier shall involve an anti-competitive cross-subsidy and all such transactions shall comply with applicable law.
- (23) Natural gas distribution company employees who have responsibility for operating the distribution system, including natural gas delivery or billing and metering, shall not be shared with an affiliated or divisional Supplier, and their offices shall be physically separated from the office(s) used by those working for the Supplier. Such natural gas distribution company employees may transfer to a Supplier provided such transfer is not used as a means to circumvent these interim standards of conduct. Any supplier shall have its own direct line management. Any shared facilities shall be fully and transparently allocated between the natural gas distribution company function and the Supplier function. The natural gas distribution company accounts and records shall be maintained such that the costs a Supplier incurs may be clearly identified.

(24) (a) Neither the natural gas distribution company nor an affiliated or divisional Supplier may directly or by implication falsely and unfairly represent:

- that the Pa PUC jurisdictionally regulated services provided by the natural gas distribution company are of a superior quality when power is purchased from an affiliated or divisional Supplier; or

- that the merchant services (for natural gas) are being provided by the natural gas distribution company rather than an affiliated or divisional Supplier;

- that the natural gas purchased from a Supplier that is not an affiliate or division of the natural gas distribution company may not be reliably delivered;

- that natural gas must be purchased from an affiliate or divisional Supplier to receive Pa PUC jurisdictional regulated services.

(b) The natural gas distribution company shall not jointly market or jointly purchase its Pa PUC jurisdictional regulated services with the services of an affiliated or divisional Supplier. This prohibition includes prohibiting the natural gas distribution company from including bill inserts in its natural gas distribution company bills promoting an affiliated or divisional Supplier's services, and further precludes a reference or link from the natural gas distribution company's web-site to any affiliated or divisional supplier.

(c) When an affiliated or divisional Supplier markets or communicates to the public using the natural gas distribution company name or logo, it shall include a disclaimer that states:

(i) That the Supplier is not the same company as the natural gas distribution company; (2) that the prices of the Supplier are not regulated by the Pa PUC; and (3) that a customer does not have to buy natural gas or other products from the Supplier in order to receive the same quality service from the natural gas distribution company. When a Supplier advertises or communicates verbally through radio or television to the public using the natural gas distribution company name or logo, the Supplier shall include at the conclusion of any

such communication a disclaimer that includes all of the disclaimers listed in this paragraph.

- (25) The natural gas distribution company must: (a) make interstate capacity available for release, assignment, or transfer to its affiliated or divisional Supplier only through the interstate pipeline electronic bulletin boards and the competitive bidding procedures in place on those interstate systems; (b) not give its affiliated or divisional Supplier any preference over non-affiliated or non-divisional Suppliers, or potential non-affiliated or non-divisional Suppliers, in matters relating to the assignment, release, or other transfer of the natural gas distribution company's capacity rights on interstate pipeline systems; and (c) not condition or tie its agreement to release, assign, or otherwise transfer interstate pipeline capacity to any agreement by a gas Supplier, customer or other third party relating to any service in which its marketing affiliate is involved.



**LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY AGREEMENT OF
ELIGO ENERGY PA, LLC**

THIS LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made and entered into as of the 1st day of October, 2012, effective as of the 24th day of August, 2012, by Eligo Energy PA, LLC, a Pennsylvania limited liability company (the "Company"), and Eligo Energy, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Member"), the Company's sole member and manager.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Company was formed as a Pennsylvania limited liability company on August 24, 2012, by the filing of Articles of Organization with the Department of State of the State of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Member desires to provide for certain agreements governing the business and affairs of the Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Name. The name of the Company is Eligo Energy PA, LLC; provided that the Manager may, from time to time, change the name of the Company to any name permitted by the Pennsylvania Limited Liability Company Law, Section 8901 *et seq.*, as the same may be amended from time to time (the "Law").

2. Company's Office, Registered Office and Registered Agent. The mailing office and street address of the principal office of the Company is 1658 Milwaukee Avenue, Suite 314, Chicago, IL 60647. The Secretary of State of the State of Pennsylvania is designated as the agent for service of process. The name and address of the Company's registered agent shall be such person and location as determined by the Manager.

3. Term. The term of the Company shall be perpetual, unless the Company is earlier dissolved in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement.

4. Business of the Company. The business of the Company shall be to engage in any lawful businesses and activities for which limited liability companies may be organized under the Law.

5. Ownership. As of the date hereof, Member owns 100% of the limited liability company interests of the Company. Any member may transfer all or any portion of his or her limited liability company interests in the Company and any transferee shall be automatically admitted as a Member.

6. Manager-Managed. The business and affairs of such Company shall be managed exclusively by the Manager and by such officers of the Company, if any, as may be appointed

from time to time by the Manager pursuant to Section 8 of this Agreement. Except where the approval of the Members is expressly required by non-waivable provisions of the Law, the Manager shall have full and complete authority, power and discretion to direct, manage and control the business, affairs and properties of the Company. Eligo Energy, LLC shall be the "Manager".

7. Powers and Authority of the Manager. Without limiting the generality of Paragraph 6, all decisions relating to the management and control of the conduct of the business of the Company and its affairs shall be made by the Manager, including, but not limited to, decisions relating to any of the following: (i) the selection of representatives of the Company to serve on the management, supervisory or other governing boards or bodies of any company or other organization in which the Company owns an interest; (ii) the hiring and termination of employees of the Company; (iii) distributions to the Member; (iv) the opening of bank accounts, the making of loans to any third party, the incurrence or refinancing of indebtedness of the Company, and the encumbering of Company property; (v) the selection of attorneys, accountants, appraisers and agents; and (vi) the entry into or performance of, on behalf of the Company, all other contracts, agreements and other undertakings and the taking of any other action as may be necessary or advisable in the judgment of the Manager or incident to carrying out in the business of the Company. Any contract, agreement, instrument or other document to which the Company is a party and which is duly authorized by the Manager may be signed by the Manager or an authorized officer of the Company, and no other signatures shall be required.

8. Officers. The Manager may appoint such officers and agents as the Manager shall deem necessary, and such officers and agents shall hold their offices for such terms and shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as shall be determined from time to time by the Manager.

9. Indemnification. The Company (to the extent of all of its assets and without any obligation on the part of any Member to contribute funds to the Company, but subject to any lien or security interests held by any person) shall indemnify and save harmless each Manager and each Member from any loss or damage incurred by it by reason of any act performed by it for and on behalf of the Company and in furtherance of the Company's interest, provided such act or acts were done in good faith and without malfeasance, gross negligence or willful misconduct on the part of the Manager or any Member. Except as otherwise expressly and specifically provided herein, a Member shall have no obligation or liability to any other Member or, except as otherwise expressly provided by the Act, to any other person or entity, in such Member's capacity as a Member.

10. Dissolution. The Company shall be dissolved by the written agreement of the Member holding a majority of the limited liability company interests.

11. Inconsistencies. In the event of any inconsistency between this Agreement and the Law, to the extent permitted by applicable law, the terms of this Agreement shall govern.

12. Application of Pennsylvania Law. This Agreement and its interpretation shall be governed exclusively by its terms and by the laws of the State of Pennsylvania.

13. Amendments. This Agreement may not be amended except in writing by the Members holding a majority of the limited liability company interests.

14. Heirs, Successors and Assigns. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Members and their heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns.

15. Creditors. None of the provisions of this Agreement shall be for the benefit of or enforceable by any creditors of the Company.



PA - Residential Customer

This agreement ("Agreement") authorizes Eligo Energy IL, LLC ("Supplier"), located at 1658 North Milwaukee Avenue, Suite 314, Chicago, IL 60647-6905, to change my ("Customer") electric supplier in the territory of (XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX). Supplier is an independent seller of natural gas service certified by the XXXXXX XXXXXXXX Commission and is not representing or acting on behalf of the Utility, any governmental bodies or consumer groups.

Service: Customer will begin receiving natural gas at the time of the first scheduled meter reading by the Utility after the date on which Customer is eligible to switch suppliers. Supply of energy to Customer shall continue pursuant to this Agreement. By executing or approving this Agreement, under the terms of Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") Supplier Program, Customer agrees to initiate service and begin enrollment.

Price: Customer will receive natural gas from Supplier at a fixed generation rate of \$0.0xxx/CCF/DTH for XXXX months, following the initial period of XX months, the generation rate will continue as a monthly variable rate that may be periodically adjusted to market conditions. Or customer may choose a month to month variable of \$0.0xxx/CCF for XXXX months after enrollment at the next applicable billing period. Customer may compare price terms by looking at the rates posted on Supplier's website (<http://www.eligoenergy.com>) and on Customer's monthly bill. In addition, Customer shall pay and be responsible for all other amounts, such as service and delivery charges, from the Utility, including any applicable taxes. Customer also understands that the Utility may charge a switching fee when enrolling with Supplier. Customer is responsible for cancelling any existing supplier agreement.

Right of Rescission: Customer may rescind the Agreement, by contacting the Supplier before the Supplier submits the enrollment request to the NGDC. Furthermore, Customer may rescind the Agreement and the pending enrollment, within 3 business days after the Utility processes the enrollment request, by contacting the Supplier. Residential customers may rescind the Agreement and the pending enrollment by contacting either the Supplier or the Utility.

Term: Service with Supplier will commence with the next available meter reading after the Utility and Supplier process the request. Service with Supplier will renew monthly until the cancellation of this Agreement by either Supplier or the Customer.

Cancellation: Customer may cancel this Agreement, for any reason, at any time, during the first twelve months of service, for a \$10.00 Cancellation Service Charge for each month remaining in the agreement. The cancellation becomes effective when Customer's new supplier or the Utility completes the change. Cancellation will not relieve Customer of any payment obligations for electricity provided to Customer by Supplier before cancellation. Customer may make such a cancellation by contacting Supplier or the Utility (orally, electronically or in writing). Customer may not be served under the same rates, terms, and conditions that apply to others when switching back to the Utility. Supplier may revert Customer to Utility for non-payment at the time of the next meter reading with at least 15 days written notice and an opportunity to cure. A final bill will be rendered within twenty (20) days after the final scheduled meter reading or, if access is unavailable, an estimate of consumption will be used in the final bill, which will be reconciled subsequent to the final meter reading.

Billing: Supplier will serve only the supply portion of Customer's electricity bill. All other services currently supplied by the Utility will continue to be supplied by the Utility. Customer will continue to receive one monthly electric bill processed and provided by the Utility in accordance with its billing practices. In the event of Customer bankruptcy, late payment, or nonpayment, Supplier has the right to cancel this Agreement.

Collection of Past Due Charges: Utility will remain responsible for collecting late payments.

Environmental Disclosure Information: Supplier will provide to the Customer, with the Agreement, information (accompanying the Agreement) regarding the approximate generation resource mix and environmental characteristics of the power supplies.

Confidentiality: Supplier will not disclose Customer's social security number and/or account number(s) without the Customer's consent except for the Supplier's own collections and credit reporting efforts, participation in programs funded by the Universal Service Fund, or assigning Customer's Agreement to another supplier.

Contact Information: In the event of an emergency such as a power failure, downed power line, or other life-threatening emergency, Customer should contact the Utility at x-xxx-xxx-xxxx (toll free) or Emergency Services at 911. For other service matters Customer can call Utility at x-xxx-xxx-xxxx (toll-free). For all other inquiries, the Customer may contact Supplier at 1-888-744-8125, 24 hours a day and 7 days a week. Customer shall contact Supplier with any change in Customer's email address and/or withdrawal of consent for electronic retention of Customer information. If Customer's complaint is not resolved after they have called Supplier and/or Utility, or for general Utility information, Customer may contact the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") for assistance at 1-800-692-7380 from 8:30 a.m. Eastern Time to 5 p.m.

Dispute Resolution: In the event of a billing dispute or a disagreement involving Supplier's service hereunder, the parties will use their best efforts to resolve the dispute. Customer should contact Supplier by telephone or in writing as provided above. The dispute or complaint relating to Customer may be submitted by either party at any time to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") by calling the ("PUC") at 1-800-692-7380 or by writing to the ("PUC") at: Bureau of Consumer Services, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265 or through its website at: http://www.puc.state.pa.us/General/onlineforms/pdf/Consumer_Complaint_Options.pdf. During the pendency of any dispute, Customer must pay the bill in full minus the specific disputed amount. Venue for any lawsuit brought to enforce any term or condition of this Agreement or to construe the terms herein shall lie exclusively in Pennsylvania. This Agreement shall be construed under and shall be governed by the laws of the Pennsylvania without regard to application of its conflicts of laws and principles.

Customer Relocation: If Customer moves to a new address within Supplier's current service territory, Customer should contact Supplier in order to re-enroll at the new location.

Changes to Agreement: Supplier may modify this Agreement, or change these terms in connection with any renewal of this Agreement, or if there are adverse changes in the laws, rules or market conditions affecting Supplier's ability to perform hereunder, by providing thirty (30) to sixty (60) days prior written notice.

Assignment: Customer may not assign this Agreement without Supplier's written consent. Customer hereby acknowledges and consents to Supplier's pledge and contingent assignment or subrogation of any and all rights and obligations hereunder. Limitations of Liability: Neither the Customer nor the Supplier shall assume liability or responsibility for any special, indirect, consequential or punitive damages for items associated with the failure of Utility to perform its duties, including but not limited to operations and maintenance of their system or interruptions of service, termination of service, or from damages arising from structural damage as a result of negligence.



The Administrative Law Judge issued a ruling on April 26, 2013, requesting clarification of certain matters contained in the application. Applicant filed a Response on May 2, 2013.

II. BACKGROUND AND AUTHORITY SOUGHT BY APPLICANT

Applicant is a limited liability corporation, under the laws of Illinois. Applicant requests a certificate of authority to operate as an ARES in the Commonwealth Edison Company ("ComEd") service territory. Applicant asserts it is not currently licensed to be an electricity supplier. Applicant asserts that it has affiliates that are licensed to be electric suppliers in New York, Maryland, and Ohio. Applicant states an affiliate has submitted an application to become an electric supplier in the District of Columbia. Applicant asserts that *no formal complaints have been filed against its affiliates in any state*; that all customer concerns have been dealt with via the customer service department. Applicant asserts it intends to offer electricity services to all residential and nonresidential customers. Applicant states it is not affiliated with an Illinois utility. Applicant states that it will be engaged in the competitive retail sale of electric power to end-use customers, utilizing the jurisdictional transmission and distribution facilities of electric distribution utilities. Applicant does not seek authority to provide single-billing services, under subpart F of Part 451. Applicant asserts it has not been denied an electric supplier license, nor has it had an electric supplier license suspended or revoked by any state.

III. REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115(d) OF THE ACT

A. General

Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will provide service only to retail customers eligible to take such services; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; and that it will comply with all other applicable Federal, State, regional and industry laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ARES. Additionally, Applicant has agreed to submit good faith schedules of transmission and energy in accordance with applicable tariffs. Applicant certifies that it will provide for review by Commission Staff on a confidential basis data related to contracts for the purchase and sale of electric power and energy. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules relating to customer authorizations, billing records, and retail electric services and agrees to retain requests for delivery services transmitted to utilities for a period of not less than two calendar years after the calendar year in which they are created. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers' data.

Applicant agrees to procure renewable energy resources as required by Section 16-115D and subsection (d) of Section 16-115 of the Act. Applicant also certifies that it will source electricity from clean coal facilities as required by Section 16-116(d)(5) of the Act. Applicant states that will not use electric generation, transmission or distribution facilities that it owns, controls or operates in serving customers.

Pursuant to the requirements of Subpart D of Part 451, Applicant certifies that any marketing materials that make statements concerning prices, terms and conditions of service shall contain information that adequately discloses the prices, terms and conditions of the products or services that it is offering or selling to the customer. Applicant also certifies that before any customer is switched from another supplier, it shall give the customer written information that adequately discloses, in plain language, the prices, terms and conditions of the products and services being offered and sold to the customer. Applicant further certifies that it will provide documentation to the Commission and to customers that substantiates any claims made regarding the technologies and fuel types used to generate the electricity offered or sold to customers. Applicant commits to provide to its customers itemized billing statements that describe the products and services provided to the customer and their prices; and an additional statement, at least annually, that adequately discloses the average monthly prices, and the terms and conditions, of the products and services sold to the customer.

Applicant certifies that it will include materials comprising the consumer education program pursuant to Section 16-117 of the Act with all initial mailings to potential residential and small commercial retail customers and before executing any agreements or contracts with such customers. Applicant certifies that it will provide

consumer education program materials pursuant to Section 16-117 of the Act, at no charge to residential and small commercial retail customers, upon request. Applicant certifies that it will provide to residential and small commercial retail customers on a semi-annual basis information on how to obtain a list of alternative retail electric suppliers that have been found in the last three years by the Commission to have failed to provide service in accordance with the terms of their contracts pursuant to Section 16-117(g) (4) (C) of the Act.

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 451.50 of Part 451, Applicant provided a License or Permit Bond in the amount of \$300,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois.

B. Financial, Technical, And Managerial

Applicant asserts that it meets the financial qualifications set forth in Section 16-115(d)(1) and Part 451. Included in Attachment D to the application is information intended to demonstrate that Applicant meets the criteria set forth in Section 451.320(a).

Applicant represents that it meets the technical and managerial qualifications set forth in Section 16-115(d)(1) of the Act and Sections 451.330 and 451.340 of Part 451. The application, Attachments E, F, and G, and supplemental information provided contain information regarding the technical and managerial qualifications of Applicant's staff and its agents or contractors. Exhibit 3 to the Response to Notice of Administrative Law Judge's Ruling contains a corporate organizational chart. Applicant provided a telephone number and facsimile number through which it states a staff member can be reached at all times.

Applicant certifies that all of its agents or contractors will comply with all Sections of Part 451 applicable to the function or functions to be performed by the respective agent or contractor.

IV. MOTION FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT

Applicant filed a verified motion for confidential treatment with respect to portions of the information attached to its application. Applicant asserts that the information includes highly confidential and proprietary information of a commercially sensitive nature. Specifically, Applicant seeks *proprietary treatment of financial information* contained in Attachment D to the application. Applicant asserts that the disclosure of this information would cause it harm in the highly competitive energy supply market. Applicant requests that the financial information be afforded proprietary and confidential treatment.

V. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

The Commission has reviewed the request for confidential treatment and finds that it is appropriate to grant a two-year period of confidential treatment for Attachment D to the application. The Commission concurs with Applicant that disclosure of the redacted information and use by a competitor is apt to cause the Applicant competitive harm. Applicant's confidential information in the Commission's possession should, therefore, be accessible only by the Commission and Commission Staff, unless such information is or becomes publicly available from another source for a period of two years.

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical, financial, and managerial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 451 and finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements. It is noted that no demonstration of compliance with the requirements of Section 451.20(d)(2) has been made and Applicant's employees are not permitted to perform such functions, and other entities are not permitted to perform such functions pursuant to contractual arrangements with Applicant.

The Commission concludes, therefore, that Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ARES in Illinois should be granted and should include the following authority:

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that Eligo Energy IL LLC is granted service authority to operate as an Alternative Retail Electric Supplier as follows:

SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED: The sale of electricity and power.

CUSTOMERS TO BE SERVED: All eligible residential and nonresidential retail customers.

GEOGRAPHIC REGION(S) SERVED: For the sale of electricity and power in the service area of Commonwealth Edison Company.

VI. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) Applicant, Eligo Energy IL LLC a limited liability corporation organized under the laws of Illinois, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an alternative retail electric supplier under Section 16-115 of the Act;

- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the parties hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact, as required by Section 16-115(d) of the Act;
- (4) Applicant has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient financial, managerial and technical resources and abilities to provide power and energy to all eligible residential and nonresidential retail customers throughout the service area of Commonwealth Edison Company;
- (5) Applicant has complied with Section 16-115(d)(1) through (5) and (8) of the Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 451;and
- (6) Section 7(g) of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq., exempts from disclosure:
 - Trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person or business where such trade secrets or information are proprietary, privileged or confidential, or where disclosure of such trade secrets or information may cause competitive harm;
- (7) as stated in the verified petition for confidential treatment and the prefatory portion of this order, portions of Applicant's documents fall within the exemption stated in Finding (6);
- (8) the documents and portions of documents for which Applicant seeks proprietary treatment, (Attachment D to the application), should be exempt from public disclosure under Section 7(g) of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act and Section 5-109 of the Act until May 15, 2015;
- (9) Eligo Energy IL LLC should be granted a certificate of service authority to operate as an alternative retail electric supplier as specified in Section V of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that Eligo Energy IL LLC is hereby granted a Certificate of Service Authority as set forth in Section V of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Eligo Energy IL LLC shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the documents and portions of documents filed by Eligo Energy IL LLC, Attachment D to the application, is afforded proprietary treatment, is exempt from public disclosure, and will be accessible only by the Commission and the Commission Staff until May 15, 2015.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.
