

Dear Lauren Langbert:

PECO is aware that Energy Auction House has applied for a license to provide brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers on the distribution system of PECO.

In making such an application, Energy Auction House could be required to provide to PECO a bond or other acceptable financial security in an amount that PECO determines to be appropriate. Energy Auction House has indicated that it intends to provide only brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers will not take title to any delivered natural gas; nor will accept any customer payments or deposits. Therefore, PECO has determined at this time that Energy Auction House does not need a bond or other financial security requirement, since they are not directly engaging in business with PECO and only providing brokering or consulting services to PECO customers. However, if the services provided by Energy Auction House or the creditworthiness requirement for PECO's exposure to Energy Auction House changes in the future, PECO reserves the right to require Energy Auction House to provide a bond or other financial security instrument.

We are pleased that Energy Auction House (“Energy Auction House”) has applied for a license to provide Natural Gas Broker/Marketer Services on the distribution system of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (“Columbia Gas”).

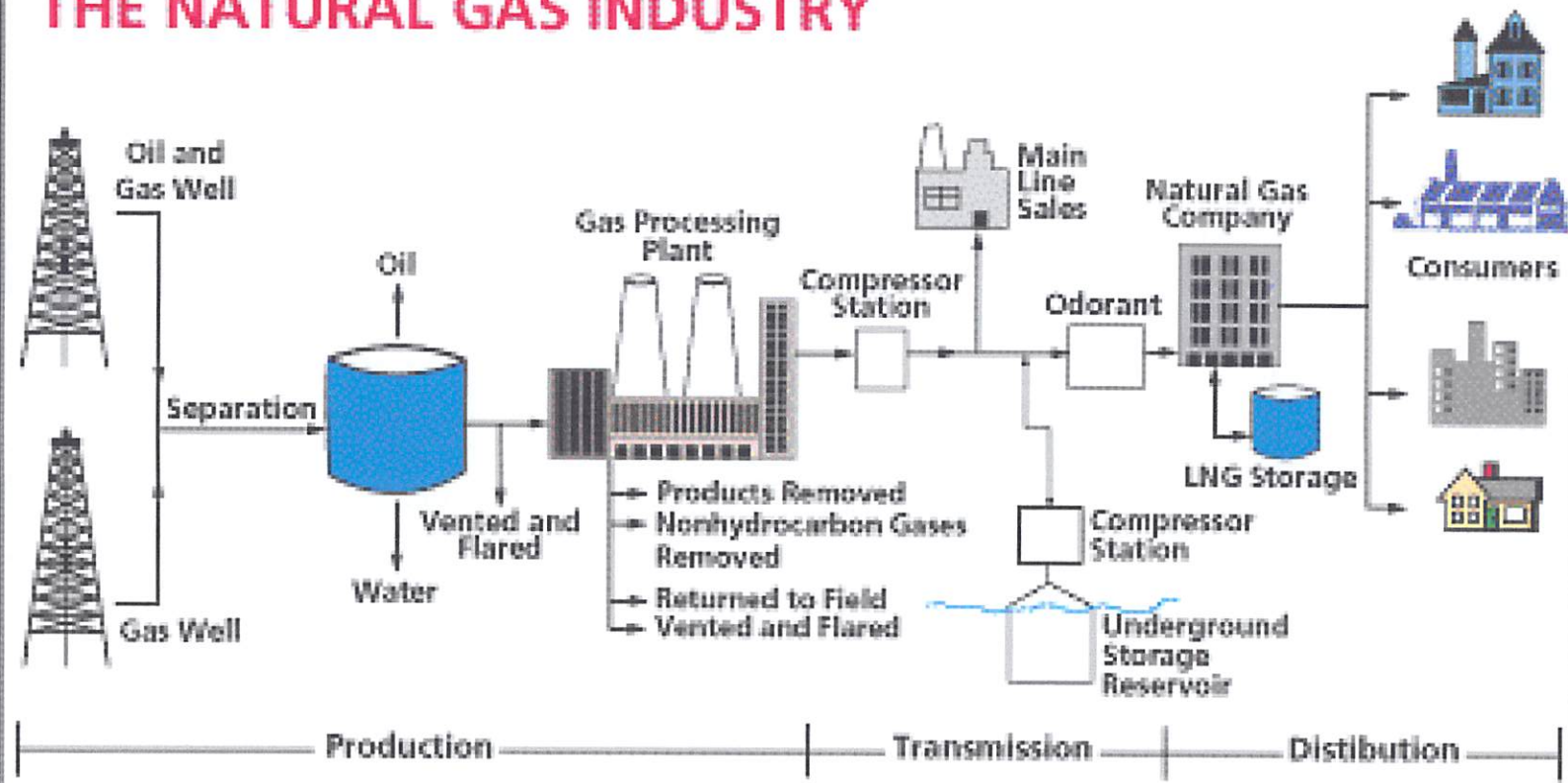

Natural Gas Pricing Components

- **Commodity Price** - the natural gas itself commonly priced at a central hub (i.e. Henry Hub in Louisiana)
- **Basis** – this is the cost of transporting the gas from the Hub to the local utility or “citygate” where it will be delivered.
- **Margin or Adder** – amount added to the price for the supplier costs and profit

Contract Pricing Options

Fixed - customers contract a certain price per therm for the duration of their contract. Each billing period their meter is read and the customer is billed their contract price times the number of therms they used.

This option provides budget certainty, stability and protection from volatile markets.

NYMEX plus Basis— Each billing period the customer's price is based on the NYMEX for that billing period plus an agreed upon adder or margin. The adder includes the basis. The customer is charged the calculated price times the number of therms used according to their meter read.

This option saves hedging and financing costs exposes the customer to volatility.

Quantity Options

- **Contracted Quantities** – Customer purchases a fixed quantity of gas at a fixed price every month from the supplier based on historical usages or known future use. If the customer uses more or less than their contracted quantity then the surplus or shortfall is bought or sold at current market prices. This is called “Balancing”.
- **100% Swing** – The customer pays for the amount of gas they use each month at the contracted price.
- **<100% Swing**- the customer pays their contracted price as long as usage falls within the swing boundaries. Any usage outside the swing is balanced at market prices.

Pricing Options

Traditional- EAH will submit customer information to various suppliers and receive pricing. EAH will compare offers and present the best to the customer.

Instant – Customers input their information on the website and instant offers from suppliers will populate.

Reverse Auction – EAH will submit customer information to suppliers and suppliers will prepare pricing. At a date and time set by the customer EAH will host a reverse auction on their web based auction platform at energyauctionhouse.com. All parties log in at the auction time and the suppliers enter their starting prices into the auction platform. The suppliers can see their competitors bids and may enter a lower price to win the business. The suppliers continue to lower their prices until the auction time ends. At the end of the auction the customer may review and sign the winning supplier's contract but has no obligation to do so.

Advantages of Reverse Auctions

Transparency

- Customers can see all supplier bids and therefore have confidence that they are getting the lowest price.
- Suppliers can see their competitors pricing and therefore have the option to reduce their price and win more business. They don't have to guess what the competition is doing.

Ease of Use

- Customers and suppliers can easily participate in an auction from any web based device anywhere in the world.
- The platform is designed to be simple and user friendly.
- The customer is under no obligation at the end of the auction should they be unsatisfied with the results for any reason.

Scheduling Auctions

All of the information needed to schedule an auction is found on the customer's electricity invoice.

Customers may register at energyauctionhouse.com and either input their bill information on the secure website or upload their bill electronically.

EAH needs a minimum of 3 days lead time to schedule an auction to allow suppliers time to prepare bids.

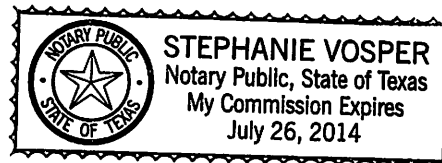

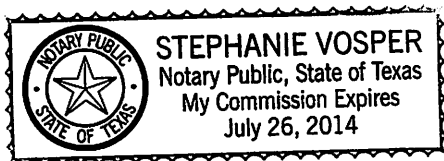

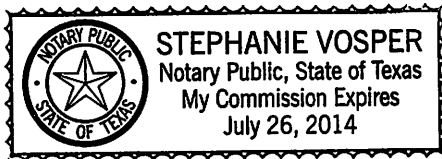
