Hope we have been of assistance to you in this matter. Please feel free to contact our office if you have any questions.

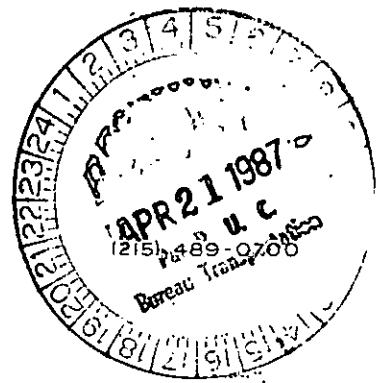
