EXCEPTIONS OF DR. HUBERT C. HUH – COMPLAINANT
TO INITIAL DECISION

1. The first Exception refers to **page 2 of the Initial Decision**, the unnumbered paragraph beginning: “On April 29, 2014, the undersigned presiding officer convened the initial telephonic hearing as scheduled. Complainant appeared *pro se* and testified on his own behalf.”

This Exception is intended to send Complainant’s comments to the Public Utility Commission and further to reprove PECO’s attorney, Shawane Lee’s conduct and remonstrate against Ms. Lee’s representation on behalf of PECO Energy against Complainant, Dr. Hubert C. Huh.

PECO’s attorney manufactured her own witness and also produced 10 Exhibits, particularly when Complainant, Dr. Hubert C. Huh, was, in the rectitude and sincerity of his thinking, severely affected by his physical illness. Ms. Lee was advised at 9:53 A.M. by Dr. Huh’s attorney, Gary Schafkopf, that he was **not** going to represent Dr. Huh, and he further advised her to tell Dr. Huh this case should be continued. Ms. Lee did not contact Dr. Huh, in order to prevent him from attending the telephonic hearing so that he will be **in default** by **not** attending this hearing. PECO’s attorney, Shawane Lee, when she learned that Dr. Huh’s attorney will **not** be representing him, wanted Dr. Huh to make **no effort to attend the hearing**, so she could present Respondent, PECO’s case **against Dr. Huh, manufacturing PECO’s own witness, and providing 10 exhibits** which Dr. Huh could **not** object to because of his physical illness at the time.

The chronology is as follows. Complainant learned at **4:48 P.M. on Monday, April 28, 2014**, that the attorney he had arranged, Gary Schafkopf, **would not** represent him at the hearing. Mr. Schafkopf had been trying to negotiate a settlement with PECO prior to the hearing. Therefore, Complainant was **out of necessity** busy preparing for the hearing, did **not** have his computer turned on before the hearing, and did **not** see until after the hearing the emails between Mr. Schafkopf and the attorney for Respondent PECO Energy Company, Shawane L. Lee. Mr. Schafkopf told Ms. Lee that he would **not** be representing Complainant and **recommended a continuance**. These emails are attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.



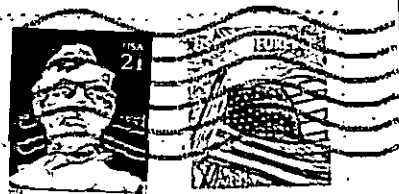
