Dear Secretary Rich:

Enclosed herewith is a copy of your letter, dated December 12, 1988, addressed to Attorney Lonny Cades, indicating the dismissal of the above-referenced application for the reasons stated.

Also enclosed herewith is a copy of a letter dated November 23, 1988, transmitting a copy of Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 effective November 30, 1988, and, receipted by the Bureau of Transportation, Financial Document Section on November 29, 1988. This tariff lists the rates, rules and regulations governing the authority purchased by Mr. Scott from Robert W. Badey at A-00068090.

In addition, this office contacted Mr. James McCarthy, Chief of your Insurance Department, who indicated that Form UCPC-31 (Cargo Certificate) had been received and accepted, and, that only Form E (Liability/Property Certificate) was deficient. Due to a grave misunderstanding between the Transferee and his insurance carrier, the Form E Certificate was never mailed to your Honorable Commission. I am now advised by Mr. Scott that a new insurance company has placed liability/property damage coverage, and that the required Form E Certificate is being mailed directly to Mr. McCarthy.

Lastly, a \$280.00 assessment bill remains outstanding for the period July 1, 1988 to June 30, 1989. This invoice was originally sent to Mr. Robert W. Badey, who subsequently went through triple by-pass heart surgery and never made any attempt to make payment without the knowledge of my client. Consequently, upon receipt of your 12-12-88 letter Mr. Scott immediately contacted Mr. William Stancavage, Chief of your Assessment Section who is sending out another invoice. This amount will be paid immediately by Mr. Scott upon receipt of the invoice.



It is hopeful that upon receipt of the paid assessment and the properly completed Form E the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission will immediately take the necessary action to remove the "recision or dismissal" of authority.

Dear Sir:

The Commission's records indicate that you have failed to comply with the necessary requirements of the Commission's order and cover letter which was sent to you on August 25, 1988. Specifically, you have failed to satisfy the requirements marked below:

File a certificate of public liability and property damage insurance (Form E).

File a cargo insurance certificate in the amount of \$2500 per vehicle (Form UCPC-31) or a cargo waiver.

File an acceptable tariff.

ASSESSMENTS

The grant of your application was expressly subject to the fulfilling of all of the three conditions within sixty (60) from August 25, 1988.

Since you have not complied with the marked requirement(s), your application for a certificate of public convenience is hereby dismissed.

Since you do not have a certificate of public convenience, any operation as a motor carrier in intrastate commerce is a violation of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. s101 et seq., and will subject you to the penalties contained therein.
