Dear Ms. Jackson,

On July 19, 2013, you contacted the Office of Administrative Law Judge (OALJ) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission in Harrisburg with information regarding your failure to appear at the June 21, 2013 hearing scheduled in the above-captioned matter. You cited the death of a close family member as the reason for failing to appear at the hearing.

Because almost a whole month has passed between the hearing date and your call to the OALJ, you are presented with two options:

- 1) You may present a copy of the death certificate issued for your family member and request, in writing, to have another hearing in the matter captioned above.
- 2) You may withdraw your present complaint, in writing, and file a new formal complaint against PECO.

Either action must be taken by no later than August 2, 2013. If you fail to take either action by August 2, 2013, I will go ahead and issue an Initial Decision dismissing your present complaint for failure to prosecute.
