





WHEREAS, the parties hereto for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, agree to become co-partners in the business of public transportation to transport, as a Class D carrier, coal from mines and stripping operations in the County of Somerset to points in the said county; no haul to exceed a distance of twenty-five (25) miles from point of origin to point of destination.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual premises and promises hereinafter stated and intending to be legally bound hereby and herein, the parties hereto agree to operate said partnership under the firm name and style of **JONES BROTHERS TRUCKING**; said business to be conducted from its business address of
