



## I. INTRODUCTION

PA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION SECRETARY'S BUREAU

On September 18, 2012, Navigant Energy, LLC ("Applicant") filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant ("ABC") in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 454, "Licensure of Retail Electric Agents, Brokers and Consultants" ("Part 454"). Applicant requests authority to offer services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

Docket No. 12-0527 does not represent Applicant's first attempt to obtain an ABC certificate. On August 21, 2012, the Commission entered an Order in Docket No. 12-0427 dismissing Applicant's request for an ABC certificate. The Commission dismissed Applicant's first request in light of significant irregularities concerning the individual Applicant named as its attorney in that docket. In light of the facts in Docket No. 12-0427, discrepancies concerning a principal's resume, and other concerns, the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") issued a ruling on October 1, 2012 requesting additional information and clarification. Applicant filed a verified response on October 17, 2012. Upon reviewing the response, the ALJ issued a second ruling on October 23, 2012 requesting additional information. Applicant filed a second verified response on November 5, 2012.

#### II. APPLICANT'S RESPONSES TO THE RULINGS

The ALJ's first ruling directed Applicant to explain in detail the circumstances that led to the dismissal in Docket No. 12-0427. As more fully explained in the Order in Docket No. 12-0427, the attorney that Applicant listed as its counsel, Elena Gallo, expressed no knowledge of Applicant when contacted by the ALJ. Given the significance of this discrepancy in the application, the ALJ issued a Proposed Order denying the requested relief. Applicant responded with a brief letter seeking leave to withdraw its application, which the Commission granted on August 21, 2012.

In response to the first ruling in the pending docket, Applicant explains that it had not officially retained Elena Gallo and Gallo Law Group as its attorney at the time it filed its application initiating Docket No. 12-0427, and as a result, Ms. Gallo was not aware of the filing or the pending application. After the initial application was withdrawn, Applicant states that it contacted Ms. Gallo and requested a consultation. Applicant reports that she agreed to represent it and has been officially retained. Applicant describes the discrepancy as "a mere oversight in timing between filing the application and contacting Ms. Gallo." Applicant states further that Ms. Gallo previously worked with one of its members on other matters, and made the assumption that she would also handle the filing in Docket No. 12-0427.

As for how the Commission can be assured that similar "oversight[s] in timing" will not occur in Applicant's dealings with customers, Applicant offers in response to the October 23, 2012 ruling that such oversights are not indicative of its primary focus on ensuring customer satisfaction, on-time quality enrollments, and complete transparency. Applicant states that it will build a technically sound, continuously educated broker-agent base that will not only represent various alternative retail electric suppliers, but more importantly be true energy advocates for the customer. Applicant adds that Mark Nakayama is well versed in the supplier contract language for energy supply agreements. Applicant states that it has taken steps to ensure that agents understand and are trained in explaining the terms and conditions of energy service agreements, as well as the timeline for a proper enrollment.

The October 1, 2012 ruling also asked Applicant if it has any connection with Navigant Consulting, Inc., the global consulting firm. Applicant states that there is no connection between it and Navigant Consulting, Inc. Applicant states further that it has officially changed its name to Navigate Power, LLC as a result of notification by Navigant Consulting, Inc. that Navigant Consulting, Inc. owned the trademark on the name Navigant Energy. As a result of the completion of the name change, the company formerly known as Navigant Energy, LLC is looking to have an ABC certificate approved under its new name, Navigate Power, LLC.

Applicant also clarified in its response to the first ALJ ruling that Mark Nakayama is an owner with a 50% equity position in Applicant, and not simply a consultant as he has been for other ABC applicants. His partner, Chris Gersch, owns the remaining half of Applicant. Applicant's response to the first ALJ ruling also addresses certain discrepancies in Mr. Nakayama's work experience.

# III. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115C OF THE ACT

Applicant is a business organized under the laws of Illinois and licensed to transact business in Illinois. Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements

pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ABC. Applicant has agreed to ensure that any person who acts on its behalf will comply with all applicable sections of Part 454. Applicant agrees that it will remain in compliance with the provisions of the Act and Part 454, and will ensure that authorizations received from customers, and all other applicable records are retained for a period of not less than three calendar years after the calendar year in which they were created. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers' data. Applicant reports that it is not licensed as an ABC in any other state. Applicant states further that no complaints have been filed against it.

# IV. FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL, AND MANAGERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16-115C

Applicant is required by Section 454.60 to demonstrate that it meets the managerial qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant must further provide an organizational chart that indicates the position of persons which satisfy the managerial qualification. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the managerial qualifications set forth in Section 454.60 through Attachments A and B. Attachment A contains a corporate organizational chart and Attachment B identifies the occupational background information of the person being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.60(a).

Applicant is required by Section 454.70 to demonstrate that it meets the technical qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the technical qualifications set forth in Section 454.70 with the information in Attachment B. Attachment B contains occupational background information on the person being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.70(a).

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 454.80 of Part 454, Applicant provided a surety bond in the amount of \$5,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant further agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct for ABCs contained in Section 454.90.

## V. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical, managerial, and financial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 454. While the Commission is still concerned about what transpired in relation to Docket No. 12-0427, the Commission accepts Applicant's explanation. The Commission advises Applicant to ensure that such oversights are not repeated. Having reviewed the entire record, the Commission finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements of the Act and Part 454. The Commission concludes, therefore, that Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC in

Illinois should be granted. Applicant's name should also be changed as requested. Accordingly, Applicant's certificate of service authority should read as follows:

## CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that Navigate Power, LLC is granted service authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

#### VI. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) Applicant, a business organized under the laws of Illinois, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC under Section 16-115C of the Act;
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the party hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact;
- (4) Applicant has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient financial, managerial, and technical resources and abilities to provide services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply to third parties in the State of Illinois;
- (5) Applicant has complied with Section 16-115C of the Act and Part 454; and
- (6) Applicant should be granted a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC as specified in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that Navigate Power, LLC is hereby granted a Certificate of Service Authority authorizing it to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant; said Certificate of Service Authority shall read as that set forth in Section V of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Navigate Power, LLC shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 III. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.

jury investigating the bomb threats against the University of Pittsburgh sued Pitt on Monday, claiming he was expelled, charged criminally and subjected to FBI scrutiny because of a dispute over use of a locker

Seamus Johnston of Johnstown wrote in the lawsuit filed pro se that he began attending Pitt's Johnstown campus in 2009 on a full tuition scholarship for commuter students.

Mr. Johnston, 24, who was born a woman, filed a name change with Pitt in 2011 and enrolled in a for-credit men's weightlifting class, according to the complaint.

During his second semester in that class, a university administrator told him that he should not use the men's locker room unless he got a court order or a birth certificate change. He was told to use a unisex locker room normally reserved for referees.

Following publication of a campus newspaper story about the dispute, Pitt police cited Mr. Johnston, declared him persona non grata in the men's locker room and eventually from the entire sports center, and finally dismissed him from the university, according to the lawsuit.

Campus police also charged Mr. Johnston criminally with indecent exposure, disorderly conduct and defiant trespass. He pleaded guilty to disorderly conduct and defiant trespass, and was on probation for 90 days.

Last year, while U.S. Attorney David Hickton was leading an effort to find the source of the Pitt bomb threats, the FBI took Mr. Johnston's computer and brought him before a grand jury. In the complaint, Mr. Johnston wrote that Pitt gave his "name to the FBI in a retaliatory furtherance of their discriminatory conduct."

Mr. Johnston said Monday that he based that accusation on "the timing, obviously, and from passing comments from the agents."

'We do intend to vigorously defend any of the claims related to this case," said Pitt spokesman Ken Service, declining to comment further.

Adam Busby of Dublin was eventually charged for making the bomb threats. He has not yet been extradited.

Mr. Johnston said he was inspired to file the lawsuit by Johnstown-area transgender student Kasev Caron's efforts to run for homecoming king despite school officials' ruling that he can only run for queen because he was born female. "I was just incensed to find out that this kind of discrimination is still going on," Mr. Johnston said. Mr. Johnston claimed

that he was a victim of gender discrimination under federal and state law, and that Pitt breached its contract by defying its own ban

# PA Cyber charter board stops paying for former CEO's defense

The board of the Pennsylvania Cyber Charter School voted Monday night to stop footing the bill for founder and former CEO Nick Trombetta's legal defense. in light of his indictment last month.

Board president Dave Jaskiewicz said the school's leaders decided in July 2012 to cover Mr. Trombetta's defense bills, though he had resigned the month before, because he had not then been accused of wrongdoing. The federal indictment. Mr. Jaskiewicz told the board. indicates that Mr. Trombetta "had reasonable cause to believe that his conduct was unlawful."

Neither he nor school chief executive officer Michael Conti knew precisely what the school

Board member Phillip Tridico voted against the motion to cut off the tab, and would not comment after the meeting. Members Tom Dorsey and Jayne Lingenfelder abstained. Four members voted for the motion.

The vote came after a closeddoor executive session lasting almost an hour and a half.

Mr. Jaskiewicz said the school has also paid the legal bills of employees called as witnesses in the probe.

"To our understanding, basically, we're done," he said, adding that if an employee was called as a witness in the future the school would pay their lawyer.

Mr. Trombetta has pleaded not guilty to the 11 count indictment accusing him of using a series of companies to obtain, and avoid taxes on, some \$990,000 in school on vendors, working with its nonprofit education management organization, the National Network of Digital Schools, to improve background checking.

"Everyone is looking around the corner a second time before we move" on any new contracts. Mr. Jaskiewicz said.

The school has applied to the Internal Revenue Service for nonprofit status, Mr. Conti

"It's been a difficult year," he said. "We are preparing to do what we've always done, and that's to continue to make this school better for its students."

The Midland-based online school now has 10,345 students with nearly 1,000 more in the application stage. Students' home districts pay tuition to PA Cyber in amounts governed by a
