AGREEMENT OF SALE
AND
MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION
CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE

THIS AGREEMENT made this 11th day of December, 1987, by and between James P. Ankin, t/d/b/a Jaspaul Services, of P.O. Box 133, Honesdale, Pennsylvania, 18431, hereinafter SELLER

AND

Maple City Transit, Inc., of 273 Terrace Street, Honesdale, Pennsylvania, hereinafter BUYER

The parties enter into the following Agreement of Sale and Management Agreement of Public Utility Commission Certificate of Public Convenience intending to be legally bound by same.

WHEREAS, Seller is the owner of para-transit service located in the area of Pike and Wayne counties, Pennsylvania; and,

WHEREAS, Seller is also the holder of a Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission certificate of public convenience #A-00107284, Folder 1; and,

WHEREAS, Seller is desirous of selling the aforesaid para-transit business together with the aforesaid certificate of public convenience for the sum of TWO

THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY and 00/100ths (\$2,250.00) DOLLARS on the terms and conditions as hereinafter set forth; and,

WHEREAS, Buyer is desirous of buying the aforesaid para-transit service, together with the aforesaid certificate of public convenience.

AND NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein the parties intending to be legally bound hereby agree as follows:

FIRST: The Seller hereby agrees to sell and the Buyer hereby agrees to buy all of Seller's right, title and interest in and to the Seller's para-transit business located in Honesdale, Pennsylvania, together with Seller's right, title and interest in and to a certain Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission certificate of public convenience bearing the docket number of A-00107284, Folder 1.

SECOND: The purchase price for the aforesaid para-transit service business and the aforesaid certificate of public convenience is Two Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100ths (\$2,250.00) Dollars, payable in cash, receipt of which Seller hereby acknowledges.

THIRD: Seller warrants that he is trading and doing business as Jaspaul Services which is a registered fictitious name with the Department of State of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

FOURTH: Seller hereby warrants that he is not a

party to any agreement for the sale, the lease, or transfer of the aforesaid para-transit services business and/or the certificate of public convenience and that the certificate of public convenience is valid and active and has not been suspended or revoked by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and is available for transfer to Buyer.

FIFTH: Seller further warrants that he is not in default under any contract agreement, lease or other documents to which he is a party and has complied with all rules, regulations and ordinances applicable to the paratransit business and is not in violation of any rules, regulations and the like of Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, nor under any investigations, Seller further warrants that no citations been issued which are outstanding regarding the above certificate of public convenience.

SIXTH: Seller further warrants that he is not aware of any protests which have been filed against his public utility certificate number A-00107284, Folder 1, nor any citations or other actions whether formal or informal or otherwise, whether alleged by the Public Utility Commission or any other governmental body that are currently outstanding.

SEVENTH: For a period of five (5) continuous years after the date of this agreement, Seller shall not directly or indirectly compete in the para-transit business

nor file for a certificate of public convenience either under his name or directly or indirectly or in partnership with anyone else for para-transit authority with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission or enter the employment of or perform any advisory or consulting service for or make a substantial investment in any company, partnership, organization, proprietorship, or other entity that engages in any business involving para-transit services such as is presently being engaged in by the Seller. This covenant not to compete will apply only to Wayne and Pike counties, Pennsylvania during the aforementioned five (5) year period of time.

EIGHTH: Seller agrees to cooperate in the transferring of the aforesaid certificate of public convenience to the Buyer and hereby agrees to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate the transfer of the same.

NINTH: Seller hereby agrees that the Buyer shall have exclusive right to manage Seller's para-transit business and the certificate of public convenience as aforesaid as of the signing of the within agreement. Buyer shall have the exclusive right to operate under Seller's Public Utility Commission certificate as aforesaid as though the said certificate had already been approved for transfer by the Public Utility Commission and as though the Buyer

were the sole and exclusive owner of the same. Seller hereby relinquishes in favor of the Buyer all of his right, title and interest to said certificate and Seller's right to operate under the parameters of the certificate para-transit authority.

TENTH: Buyer shall operate said para-transit business in a reasonably prudent manner and will carry adequate insurance and proof of the same and adhere to the tariff provisions on file with the Public Utility Commission. Buyer will also comply with all laws, rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, as well as the various agencies of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

ELEVENTH: Buyer hereby agrees to hold Seller harmless from the date hereof and indemnify him should Buyer fail to comply with any of the aforesaid rules, regulations and laws.


TWELFTH: This agreement shall inure to the benefit of and bind the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

THIRTEENTH: This agreement constitutes the entire understanding of the parties and supersedes any and all prior agreements and negotiations between them. There are no representations or warranties other than those expressly set forth herein.

FOURTEENTH: If any term, condition, clause or provision of this agreement shall be determined or declared to be void or invalid in law or otherwise, then only that term, condition, clause or provision shall be stricken from this agreement and in all other respects this Agreement shall be valid and continue in full force, effect and operation. Likewise, the failure of any party to meet its obligations under any one or more of the paragraphs herein, with the exception of the satisfaction of the conditions precedent, shall in no way void or alter the remaining obligations of the parties.


