

Dear Ms. Chiavetta:

American PowerNet Management, LP is a licensed Electric Generation Supplier in Pennsylvania. Presently, we are licensed as a broker/marketer. We selected this category as a "best-fit" option based on our business model and the choices available in the application form in use at that time at the time of our application. Our business model changed as of January 1, 2010 when American Powernet Management, LP transformed itself into an electricity supplier and began taking title to electricity in Pennsylvania for a number of customers. It was only about two weeks ago that I discovered that our present license was never modified to accommodate this change in our business model and that we did not provide notice to the Commission of this change. We have been operating as a supplier and a broker/marketer since January 1, 2010 and to the best of my knowledge we have complied with all necessary reporting requirements.

By this letter we are requesting that our license by modified in such a way as to be an approved supplier within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. We are requesting this modification to assure that our operations are fully aligned with the level of approval granted by the Public Utility Commission. If necessary, we request that the license modification be made retroactive to January 1, 2010 when our business model changed.

We understand that it is necessary for us to serve all required parties with copies of this request.

We have served all the required parties with a copy of this letter regarding our request for modification to our Electric Generation Supplier License. A copy of the signed Certificate of Service is follows this letter.
