On or about June 2, 2014 I responded to the Interim Orders that I received May 28, 2014, and May 30, 2014.

At the time I offered new evidence, exhibits to confirm that the company, UGI, Utilities, had indeed submitted false information regarding an agreement made to reconnect the service, as well as numerous other falsehoods, by way of NUNC PRO TUNC.

While my previous correspondence was met quickly with scalding reprimand, and fierce support for the company, my response has gone unanswered.

No approval for the new exhibits have been granted, although the company was allowed to submit in a most untimely manner.

I am asking that the case please go forward and I be allowed to submit the documentation to farther prove that the company has acted outside of the laws, non-compliant of the PUC laws, the company tariff, have submitted false documentation, as well as given false testimony, regarding the deliberate manipulation of this account to force a shut off, manipulated payments to cause a shut off and refuse reconnection of service under those same laws,
