Pursuant to Section 5.24 (b) of the Commission's regulations, UGI Utilities, Inc., (UGI) hereby represents and certifies to the Commission that the referenced Formal Complaint has been resolved to the satisfaction of the Complainant.

Complainant and UGI have agreed as follows: After installation of a new service line, Complainant has agreed to exclusively use UGI natural gas utility service for space and hot water heating at the Knights of Columbus building at 170 North 9th Street in the City of Lebanon, Pennsylvania. Based on Complainant's commitment to the use of natural gas service, under the terms of UGI's tariff a contribution-in-aid of construction will not be required for the new service line.
