

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Roland T. Barry, t/a ABC—EZ Moving Co., (Carrier), furnishes household goods in use services originating in Allegheny County and transported distances of forty (40) miles or less as more thoroughly described in the Commission's Order granting authority at A-00108005.

Carrier has filed Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 8, on June 19, 2006.

Carrier proposes to increase its hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 9%. Carrier currently charges \$75.00 per hour and proposes an increase to \$82.00 per hour (9%). The current hourly rates have been in effect since December 8, 2003.

Carrier has submitted a tariff and documentation, in compliance with 52 Pa. Code §23.67(c), for carriers of household goods in use, with gross annual intrastate revenues of less than \$200,000 and an operating ratio of not less than 93%.

ANALYSIS

In order to generate this revenue increase, Carrier proposes increases in its hourly charge. Carrier proposes to increase its 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge of \$75.00 per hour to \$82.00 per hour. This would be an increase of 9%. We conclude that the data compiled and submitted by the carrier supports this increase.


CONCLUSION

We have determined that Roland T. Barry, t/a ABC—EZ Moving Co. has submitted the documentary justification to support the proposed revenue increase and that the increase is not of an excessive amount based on the operating ratio. We conclude that the increase will be sufficient to provide safe, dependable and continuous service to the public: THEREFORE,
