Dear Resident,

Construction of the Clarion-Limestone Sewer Extension project should be complete by the fall of 2014. This \$4.5 million upgrade will provide reliable sewer service for local residents and address environmental issues created by failing septic systems.

Residents will be able to connect their sewer laterals to the new sewer main once the project has been completed and inspected. Residential sewer lateral connections to the new main cannot be made until the entire sewer main project has been completed, tested and inspected. Pennsylvania American Water will notify each resident as well as Clarion Township when the entire sewer main system has been approved and ready for the connection of residential sewer laterals.

Residents will be responsible for any and all costs required to connect their existing sewer service from their homes to Pennsylvania American Water's service lateral, as well as costs associated with taking their existing on-lot septic system out of service in accordance with the County Health Department and/or the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) Agency. Residents who will connect to pressurized sewer mains or who require service at an elevation lower than the gravity sewer main will provide will be required to purchase and install a sewage grinder pump with pressure sewer lateral piping.

Once you are notified that sewer service is available, each resident will need to contact our customer service center at 1-800-565-7292 to begin the sewer service application process. Residents will be required to connect to the sanitary sewer per the mandatory sewer tap-in requirements within the Clarion Township Wastewater Ordinance. Questions regarding when residents must connect to the sewer main as it pertains to Clarion Township's ordinance should be directed to the Clarion Township office at 814-764-5222.

We look forward to working with Clarion Township to complete the project in a timely manner and with each resident who will benefit from the new sewer main. If you have any questions about the project or how much it may cost you to connect to the system, please contact me at 814-226-6240.
