Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

This filing is submitted as compliance with the Order of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the "Commission"), adopted August 21, 2014 and entered August 22, 2012, in Docket No. C-2014-2417325 (the "Order") which approved a Joint Petition for Approval of Unanimous Settlement of All Issues ("Settlement"), filed by West Penn Power Company ("West Penn" or the "Company"), the Office of Consumer Advocate ("OCA") and the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("BI&E"). In the Order, the Commission adopted the Recommended Decision of Administrative law Judge Mary D. Long approving the Settlement without modification.

According to the terms of the Settlement, once the period for seeking reconsideration of any Commission order approving the Settlement has expired without the filing of any petition for reconsideration, West Penn shall: 1) make a payment of \$1.3 million to the Commission payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania within thirty (30) days of the Commission's approval of the Settlement without further condition or modification ("Payment"); 2) notify OCA and BI&E that Payment has been made; 3) withdraw the appeal filed by West Penn pending before the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania at No. 656 CD 2014; and 4) withdraw West Penn's Petition pending before the Commission at Docket No. P-2014-2415521.



The period for seeking reconsideration of the Commission's Order expired on September 8, 2014. To West Penn's knowledge, no petition for reconsideration has been filed with the Commission.




