**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE**

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. A telephonic hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Monday, September 15, 2014 at 1:00 p.m.
2. The Complainant's formal complaint alleges voltage issues at her residence located at 2144 Aquetong Road, New Hope, PA.
3. During a recent pre-hearing resolution conference call, the Complainant indicated that she had some issues with her meter.
4. PECO Energy sent a high bill field technician to the Complainant's residence to investigate the Complainant's meter concerns. The Complainant requested that PECO Energy remove her current meter, test the meter, and install a new meter.
5. PECO Energy has agreed to remove the current meter, test the meter and install a new meter. However, the meter removal and installation cannot be completed prior to the hearing on Monday.
6. Accordingly, PECO Energy is requesting a continuance of the hearing to remove and install another meter as well as test the meter.

7. PECO Energy will offer the testing data and report from the current meter at the time of the hearing.

8. PECO Energy contacted the Complainant's attorney, Keith J. Williams, Esquire, and he has no objection to PECO Energy's request for a continuance.

9. PECO Energy therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
