AGREEMENT OF SALE

THIS AGREEMENT, Made this 18th day of January, 1987, by and between BESSIE L. PENCIL, Executrix of the Estate of Carl L. Pencil, R. D. 2, Bedford, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as "Seller", and BERNARD L. FETTER, R. D. 2, Box 637, Bedford, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as "Buyer".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Carl R. Pencil, at the time of his death on October 8, 1986, was the holder and owner of a Certificate of Public Convenience as follows: (1) Report and Order Approving Trucking Service dated March 29, 1938, Application Docket No. 30184, Folder No. 2; (2) Supplemental Order dated August 19, 1981, Application Docket No. A-00030184, Folder 2; and (3) Order dated July 17, 1984, Docket No. A-00030184, Folder 2, Amendment B.; and

WHEREAS, Letters Testamentary were issued to Bessie L. Pencil as Executrix of the Estate of Carl R. Pencil by the Register of Wills of Bedford County on October 16, 1986; and

WHEREAS, said Certificate of Public Convenience is presently held by the Executrix of the Carl R. Pencil Estate, pursuant to Title 52, Pennsylvania Code Section 31.4(b); and

WHEREAS, Bessie L. Pencil is desirous of selling the same; and

WHEREAS, Bernard L. Fetter is desirous of purchasing the rights represented by Certificate of Public Convenience No.

A-00030184 issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and presently owned by the legal representative of the Carl R. Pencil Estate.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and contingent upon the approval by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission of an application for transfer of the rights represented by Certificate of Public Convenience No. 00030184 now pending before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, and in which Bessie L. Pencil, Executrix of the Estate of Carl R. Pencil, is the transferor and Bernard L. Fetter is the transferee, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Upon approval by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission of the application for transfer now before them pending, the Buyer shall pay to the Seller, for all her right, title and interest in and to those privileges and rights represented by Certificate of Public Convenience No. A-00030184 heretofore issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND (\$8,000.00) DOLLARS, to be paid as follows:

\$200.00, which sum is presently held in escrow by Ray G. Replogle, Esq., 12 Public Square, Bedford, Pennsylvania, escrow agent mutually agreed upon by the parties hereto, shall be paid to Seller at the time of approval of the application for transfer of said Certificate of Public Convenience by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. The balance of the purchase price, \$7,800.00, shall be paid by the Buyer to the Seller, in cash, at the time of

approval of the application for transfer of said Certificate of Public Convenience by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

3. In the event the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission fails or refuses to approve the transfer of the aforementioned Certificate of Public Convenience to the Buyer, then this Agreement shall be null and void, and the consideration deposited in escrow shall be returned to the Buyer by the escrow agent, less any legal costs for services in connection with this Agreement.

4. The parties hereto intend to be legally bound by the terms hereof, and it is intended that this Agreement shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.

O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission through an application submitted on March 2, 1984. Public notice of the application was advertised in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of April 14, 1984.

The application is not opposed and is certified to the Commission for its decision without hearing. The record consists of verified statements submitted by the applicant and one supporting shipper.

shipper has demonstrated that although it handles much of its own traffic in private carriage, peak season demands necessitate the use of common carriers. The shipper frequently has calls for smaller shipments for which the equipment operated by Pencil appears to be ideally suited. His close proximity to the plant facilitates prompt delivery service.

It is apparent that the applicant, who has been certificated since 1938, is well suited to perform the required transportation. He has been serving the shipper for many years in a satisfactory manner and should have no difficulty in increasing the scope of that service.

We find:

1. That the applicant is fit, willing and able to provide the proposed transportation.

2. That the applicant has demonstrated that a public need exists for the service proposed.

3. That approval of the application is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application be and is hereby approved and that the certificate issued to the applicant on March 29, 1938, as amended, be further amended to include the following right:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, 2-B limestone, for use as anti-skid material, from the plant of New Enterprise Stone & Lime Co., Inc., located in the township of Snake Spring, Bedford County, to points in the counties of Bedford and Somerset.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it shall have complied with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code and the rules and regulations of the Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

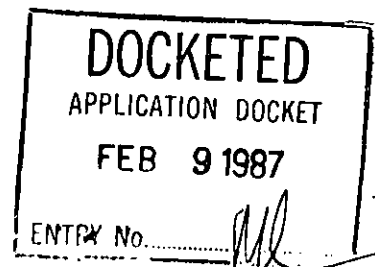

Fetter, for the right to begin to transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, (1) as a Class B carrier, feed, between points in the borough of Bedford, Bedford County; (2) livestock, lime, stone, sand and building brick, between points in the county of Bedford and within twenty (20) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of said county; (3) farm products and supplies, between points in the borough of Bedford, Bedford County, and within 20 miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of said borough; and (4) 2-B limestone, for use as anti-skid material, from the plant of New Enterprise Stone & Lime Co., Inc., located in the township of Snake Spring, Bedford County, to points in the counties of Bedford and Somerset; which is to be a transfer of the rights authorized under the certificate issued at A-00030184, F. 2, to Carl R. Pencil, (deceased), subject to the same limitations and conditions.
