By this letter, BP Energy Company, a licensed natural gas supplier authorized to provide service in Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania's service territory, respectfully requests authority to expand its service area to include large commercial, industrial and governmental customers within the UGI Utilities, Inc., service territory. Enclosed is correspondence from UGI indicating that BP Energy Company has satisfied all financial obligations to serve transportation customers on UGI's system.

By way of background, BP Energy filed a License Application on August 17, 2005, to operate as a supplier of natural gas supply services in the entire Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. On September 26, 2005, BP Energy filed Proofs of Publication evidencing BP Energy's notice of its License Application to newspapers across the Commonwealth. By letter dated October 18, 2005, BP Energy Company requested that the Commission permit BP Energy Company to begin providing service on an initial basis to customers on the Columbia Gas system. As BP Energy Company received proof of its financial responsibility from other Pennsylvania local distribution companies ("LDCs"), however, BP Energy Company reserved the right to submit them to the Commission and request that certificates of public convenience be issued such that BP Energy Company may begin providing retail service in the other relevant LDC service territories. By Order entered November 3, 2005, the Commission granted BP Energy's Application and issued a Certificate of Public Convenience permitting BP Energy to become a licensed natural gas supplier in Columbia's service territory.

Consistent with its October 18, 2005, correspondence reserving the right to expand its service area, BP Energy now seeks to provide service to large commercial, industrial and governmental customers in UGI's service territory. BP Energy has satisfied the Commission's requirements to provide service in UGI's service territory by its prior public
