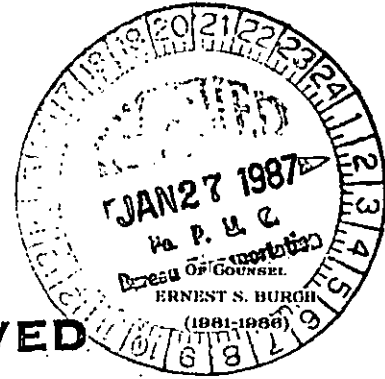



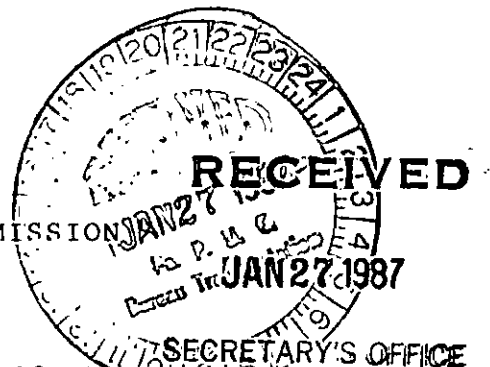

To Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission:

1. The name and address of the Applicant are Bucks County Transport, Inc., 70 West Oakland Avenue, Doylestown (Bucks County) Pennsylvania 18901.

2. The name and address of Applicant's attorney are James D. Campbell, Jr., Campbell, Spitzer, Davis & Turgeon, 130 State Street, Post Office Box 1000, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17108. ✓

3. Applicant designates James D. Campbell, Jr., Campbell, Spitzer, Davis & Turgeon, 130 State Street, Post Office Box 1000, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17108, as the person upon whom service of any notice, process or order of the Public Utility Commission may be made.

4. Applicant is a corporation. Applicant was organized under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania and attaches hereto as an exhibit a statement of its charter purpose.

5. Applicant does not presently hold any certificate of public convenience or permit.

6. The brokerage operations conducted or proposed to be conducted by Applicant are as follows:

A. Since January, 1986, Applicant has served as the agent and alter ego of the County of Bucks in connection with the provision of transportation services to the citizens of Bucks County, and in particular subsidized service funded by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation ("Section 203" Transportation) and transportation funded by the Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare ("Medical Assistance" Transportation). It performs the same identical functions that the Bucks County Office of Public Transportation Services, an agency of the county, had performed prior to 1986. The Bucks County Office of Public Transportation had previously coordinated, arranged, and at times provided, transportation for participants in these programs.

B. Applicant, as a separate non-profit corporate entity, has taken over the previous operations of the Bucks County Office of Public Transportation Services pursuant to an agreement with the county commissioners.

C. In serving as an authorized agent and instrumentality of Bucks County, for the provision of the services herein described, Applicant has relied upon previous legal opinions of the Commission staff which have held such transportation to be exempt from regulation by the Commission. All of the service in question has been rendered within the municipal boundaries of Bucks County, and the county exercises substantial control over all transportation operations including fares, hours of service, level of service, and other aspects of service.

7. Applicant is fit, willing and able properly to perform the brokerage services for which license is here asked and to conform to the lawful orders or regulations of this commission, and the proposed service is consistent with the public interest for the following reasons:


The travelling public in Bucks County, particularly senior citizens and handicapped citizens, require the service in question. If the services presently rendered by Applicant should be found by the Commission to be non-exempt from regulation, Applicant will need authority to arrange and coordinate transportation with certificated carriers as a properly licensed broker, rather than an exempt instrumentality of county government.

8. In the execution of any contract, agreement or arrangement to sell, provide, procure, furnish or arrange for the transportation of passengers, subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, Applicant will employ only those carriers by motor vehicle who have complied with the provisions of that law and have been issued certificates of public convenience to transport as common carriers or permits to transport as contract carriers and only such carriers as have, by virtue of such certificates or permits, the right to furnish the transportation.

Wherefore, Applicant prays that the Commission issue to Applicant a Brokerage License to sell or offer to sell transportation subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, or to contract, agree, or arrange to provide, procure, furnish, or arrange for such transportation, or to hold itself out, by advertisement, solicitation or otherwise, as one who sells, provides, procures, contracts or arranges for such transportation.



PROCEDURE FOR INCORPORATION
(NON-PROFIT CORPORATION)

The Pennsylvania Department of State is the granting authority for all non-profit corporations and is the storehouse for those papers and other related corporation papers. In order to incorporate a business in Pennsylvania:

1. Call the Corporation Bureau, Department of State at (717) 787-1057 to determine if the name is available. Note that this does not reserve the name.
2. If you wish to reserve the name send a letter of form DSCB:17.3B and a check for \$10 to reserve the name for 60 days.
3. Prepare Articles of Incorporation in the proper format, as prescribed in Title 15, Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes 7316, and exemplified in the form DSCE:7316, Articles of Incorporation. Domestic Non-Profit.
4. Send the following documents to the Secretary of the Commonwealth William R. Davis at Room 308, North Office Building, Harrisburg, PA 17120, either by mail or in person:
 - a. Name reservation, if applicable.
 - b. Consent to Appropriation of Name form 17.2 or Consent to Use Similar Name form 17.3, if applicable.
 - c. Articles of Incorporation - the articles will be filed and returned immediately upon receipt by the Bureau.
 - d. \$75 check, draft or money order payable to the Secretary of the Commonwealth in payment of the filing fee.
5. Publish in two newspapers of general circulation, in English, in the county where the initial registered office of the corporation is located either the intention to file or the filing of the Articles of Incorporation. One newspaper should be the legal newspaper, if any.
6. The Secretary of the Commonwealth will review, file, copy, microfilm and return the original Articles of Incorporation. No Certificate of Incorporation is issued for non-profit corporations.

7. Amendment Adopted by Corporation

The purpose of the Corporation is:

1. To promote and provide shared-ride transportation services for the general public, including the elderly and the handicapped citizens of Bucks County by direct ownership and operation of transportation vehicles, by contract, or other basis, with qualified public or private transportation organizations, or by any other means.
2. In addition, said corporation/organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue Service Law)
3. No part of the net earnings of the corporation/organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the preceding paragraph. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
4. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation/organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation/organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
5. Upon the dissolution of the organization/corporation, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation/organization, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation/organization in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific

purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the County in which the the principal office of the corporation/organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
