Dear Commission,

I, Bruce Boynton, president of B and M Moving LLC am writing this letter to ask for the fine not to be imposed on my company. I am a small business, and we typically rent vehicles through UHaul to use in our business. I was incorrectly advised when we started the business that I did not need PUC # due to the fact that we rented trucks and that all that was needed was the business insurance.

As of May 9th of this year, we were responding to a request for a move of a table for \$50. It was a small request and utilized my personal vehicle to perform the move. At that time we were informed by your enforcement officers that we needed operating authority, a Certificate of Public Convenience. I immediately began application for the Certificate, along with the DOT, and ceased operations. We have been having trouble finalizing our authority due to we do not own trucks. We do carry business insurance, and always have, but we are being told by the insurance company that they cannot provide the documents needed without a vehicle insured for the business. We are in the process of buying a truck to address the insurance company being able to file the documents needed for the PUC. They will not send that form on rented equipment. All other forms have been filed.

As for May 9th, we were providing moving services without a PUC. I understand not knowing I needed the PUC authority is no excuse, but please consider that we are a very small business, barely surviving. The information that PUC # was not needed because we rented trucks made sense at the time.

The \$ 1000 fine is a large portion of the income generated from this company. We want to be compliant and are trying very hard to be compliant, and survive as a business. Please consider eliminating the fine or possibly reducing greatly. Your consideration in this matter is greatly appreciated.

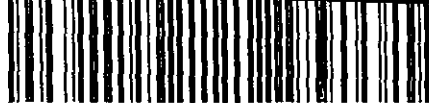

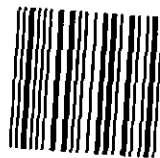
