ECAP proposes to bring together small end users, including low income customers and other residential and commercial customers in order to increase their access to affordable and clean electricity including: energy efficiency, renewable power, and competitively priced electricity. Many of the customerswe intend to serve will not be able to access competitively priced energy services on their own.

ECAP does not intend to take title to the supply of electricity.

ECAP does not intend to bill customers for their electricity. ECAP may take title to electricity and/or enter into agreements with third parties to supply electricity to ECAP customers. ECAP bills customers for electricity by including supplier charges on the consoldiated bill prepared by the utility.
