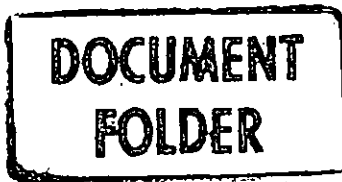
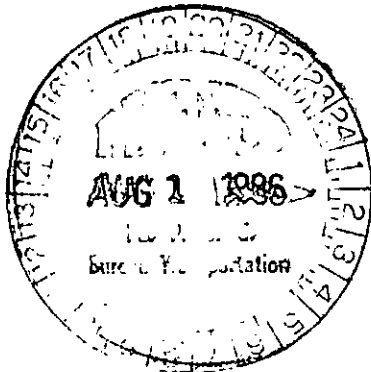

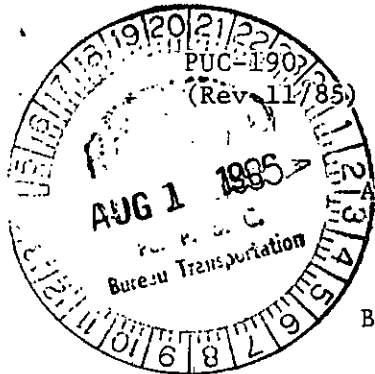

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 29th day of July, 1986, by and between HARVEY C. GASTLEY, of 224 Table Rock Road, Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, 17325, party of the first part, AND GASTLEY'S MOVING & STORAGE, INC., whose principal place of business is at 224 Table Rock Road, Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, 17325, party of the second part.

WHEREAS, the said Harvey C. Gastley is the holder and operator of certain public carrier rights in and about the Borough of Gettysburg and to points within 200 miles by the usually travelled highways of the limits of the said Borough and vice versa under Application Docket No. A.92550, Certificate of Public Convenience having been issued November 29, 1965, to the said Harvey C. Gastley, and a supplemental report and order modifying the said Certificate of Public Convenience having been entered to Folder No. 1Am-B under the said Application Docket No. A92550; and

WHEREAS, the party of the first part has agreed to sell and convey and party of the second part has agreed to purchase all of the right, title and interest of said Harvey C. Gastley in and to said carrier rights, together with certain equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Agreement witnesseth, that party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00, hereby covenants and agrees to sell and convey all of his rights hereinabove described unto party of the second part, upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Party of the second part shall proceed in due course at its own

expense to procure approval of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to the transfer of the rights as above set forth.

2. Party of the first part will execute any and all necessary petitions and other documents and will furnish such information as shall be required promptly upon request by the party of the second part for the purpose of completing the processing of application to have the transfer approved.

3. Upon approval of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, the party of the first part shall transfer said operating rights unto party of the second part, together also with the following described personal property:

4. Until the time for settlement is provided under this Agreement, the party of the first part will continue to operate the said trucking service as it has been operated and will be entitled to all the receipts and shall be liable for all of the expenses of said operation.

5. In the event the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission fails to approve the transfer within a reasonable time and said failure is due to no fault by party of the second part, this Agreement shall be terminated.

(i) All of the issued shares of the corporation of all classes, exclusive of treasury shares, shall be held of record by not more than _____ persons.

(ii) All of the issued shares of the corporation of all classes, exclusive of treasury shares, shall be held of record by not more than the smaller of [ten] fifteen "shareholders" within the meaning of Subchapter S of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or 30 persons.

(b) All of the issued shares of all classes of the corporation shall be subject to one or more of the restrictions on transfer permitted by section 613.1 of the Business Corporation Law (15 P.S. § 1613.1).

(c) The corporation shall make no offering of any of its shares of any class which would constitute a "public offering" within the meaning of the Securities Act of 1933, as amended.

2. (Optional: BCL § 372B) A person (other than an estate) who is not an "individual" or who is a "non-resident alien," in either case within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended ("Code"), shall not be entitled to be a holder of record of shares of the corporation. Only a person whose consent is currently in effect to the election of the corporation to be treated as an electing small business corporation under Subchapter S of the Code and a shareholder who has not affirmatively refused to consent to the election within sixty days after he acquires his stock, shall be entitled to be a holder of record of shares of the corporation.

3. (Optional: BCL § 382) The business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the shareholders of the corporation rather than by a board of directors.

4. (Optional: § 376B) The status of the corporation as a "close corporation" within the meaning of the Business Corporation Law shall not be terminated without the affirmative vote or written consent of (all holders of) (shareholders holding _____ of the) shares of all classes of the corporation.
