I have been with Knoll North America, Inc. and its predecessor for twelve (12) years and I have held my present position for about three and one-half years. Because of my duties, I am aware of the transportation needs of my corporation including those for intrastate commerce in Pennsylvania.

I am familiar with the above-captioned application of North American Van Lines Inc. ("applicant") and am authorized to make this statement in support thereof. In approximately August of 1990, Westinghouse Electric Corporation formed a company which it named "Westinghouse Acquisition Corporation." Westinghouse Acquisition Corporation bought the assets of Knoll International, Inc. and changed the name of Knoll International, Inc. to Westinghouse Acquisition Corp. Simultaneously, Westinghouse Acquisition Corp. changed its name to Knoll International, Inc. On or about January 1, 1992, Knoll International, Inc. and its

subsidiary, Shaw-Walker Corporation, merged into Knoll North America, Inc.


