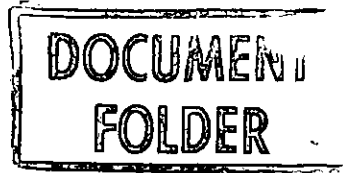

Enclosed is the compliance order issued by the Commission in this proceeding.

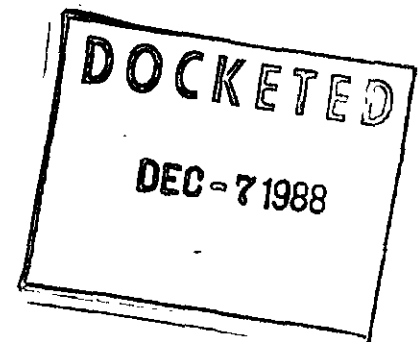
The applicant will not be permitted to operate or engage in any transportation granted by the enclosed order until a tariff has been prepared and filed in accordance with the enclosed instructions.

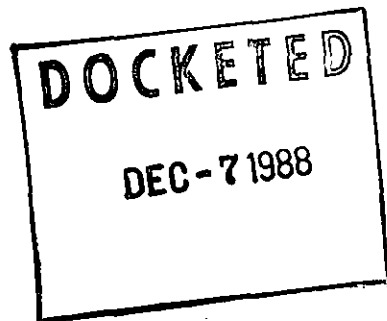

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O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed June 28, 1988. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of July 16, 1988. No protests were filed and the application is certified to the Commission for its decision without an oral hearing. The record consists of a verified statement submitted by the applicant.

Al's Leasing, Inc. (applicant), is a Pennsylvania corporation domiciled at R. D. #1, Canton, Bradford County. By the instant application, the applicant seeks to amend its contract carrier permit so as to be authorized to transport property (except in bulk) for The Paper Magic Group, Inc., between points in Pennsylvania. Currently, the applicant is authorized to transport as a contract carrier, property (except in bulk), for Shop-Vac Corp. and a wholly-owned subsidiary.

In addition to its terminal facility in Canton, the applicant also has facilities located in Elmira Heights, NY. All equipment is dispatched through a central dispatch procedure. The equipment available to provide

transportation includes 24 tractors and 76 trailers owned by the applicant, with two additional tractors being leased.

It is the intention of the applicant to provide the shipper with the services requested. Included in these services will be scheduled pickups and deliveries, as well as expedited pickups and deliveries. The applicant is anticipating no difficulty in meeting the transportation requirements of the shipper.

The shipper in the instant proceeding, The Paper Magic Group, Inc., is a manufacturer of labels and various associated paper products. Traffic to be tendered the applicant will consist of such items as labels, tags, seals, writing tablets, cutouts and raw paper in rolls.

As evidence of its intention to enter into a contractual arrangement with the shipper, the applicant has submitted a bilateral contract. The contract is in compliance with Commission regulations as set forth at 52 Pa. Code §31.45, and is acceptable as filed.

The record indicates that the applicant is fit to hold additional contract carrier authority. Approval of the application will not interfere with the service, safety and regulation of common carriers.

We find:

1. That the applicant is fit, willing and able to provide the additional contract carrier service.
2. That approval of the application will be consistent with the policy set forth at 66 Pa. C.S. §2501(a); THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application be and is hereby approved, and that the contract carrier permit issued to the applicant on January 7, 1988, be amended to include the following right:

To transport, as a contract carrier by motor vehicle, property, for the The Paper Magic Group, Inc., between points in Pennsylvania.

subject to the following condition:


No right, power or privilege is granted to transport property in bulk.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it shall have complied with the requirements of the Public Utility Code and the rules and regulations of this Commission relating to the filing of a schedule of minimum rates and charges in accordance with 66 Pa. C.S. §2502.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein, to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the carrier, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.
