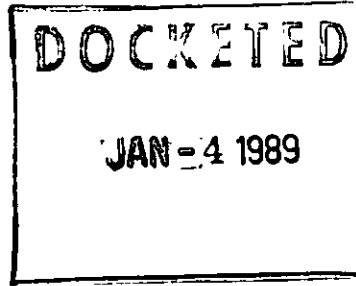

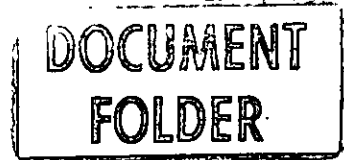

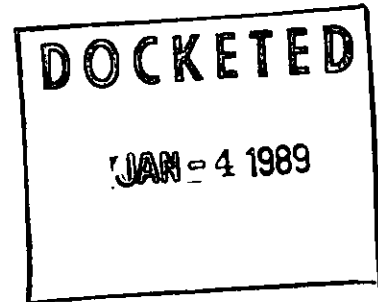

O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed March 4, 1988. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of April 9, 1988. There were two protests which were withdrawn without amendment and the record is now certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing. The record consists of verified statements entered by the applicant and the supporting shipper.

KLT, Inc. (applicant) represented by Kenneth L. Teaman, submitted a verified statement in which Mr. Teaman avers that he is president and sole

owner of the applicant and as such is involved in the day to day operations. KLT, Inc. is located at R.D. #3, Bellefonte, Centre County. Mr. Teaman is also a fifty (50) percent owner of the supporting shipper, Teaco, Inc. There is a clear distinction made between the companies and financial and legal affairs are kept separate at all times.

Terminal facilities are in Bellefonte and communications are maintained by commercial telephone service. Applicant operates a 1973 Ford toter which is specially designed for the transportation of mobile homes. Additional units will be acquired as needed. The applicant conducts pre-trip and post-trip equipment inspections and maintains its equipment to comply with all regulations.

Financial data submitted by the applicant shows an operating gross of \$3,431.50, expenses of \$2,058.90 with gross profits of \$1,372.60 to date in 1988. Capital stock is shown with a value of \$1,000 and liabilities consist of a demand note for \$9,000.00.

The supporting shipper, Teaco, Inc., t/d/b/a Valley Homes and Valley Mobile Homes needs the services of the applicant to deliver and move new and used mobile homes from its own facilities and from customer locations to other sites. Teaco also delivers and erects manufactured homes for which transportation is needed from its facilities or the manufacturing plant to the customer's site. Service must include the set-up and installation of units, so that a transportation company must also have individuals qualified for this function. The shipper is familiar with the applicant and is sure of its ability to meet the shipper's needs.

A review of the record shows that the applicant has the equipment, experience, ability and fitness necessary to provide the service proposed.

We find:

1. That the applicant currently operates pursuant to a common carrier certificate granted January 29, 1988.
2. That the applicant has the equipment, experience and fitness necessary to provide the proposed service.
3. That the applicant has shown that a need exists for the service as proposed.
4. That approval of the application is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application is hereby approved and that the certificate issued to the applicant on January 29, 1988, be amended to include the following right:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, mobile homes and manufactured homes for Teaco, Inc., t/d/b/a


Valley Homes and Valley Mobile Homes, between
points in Pennsylvania.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it shall have complied with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code and the rules and regulations of this Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein, to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the carrier, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.
