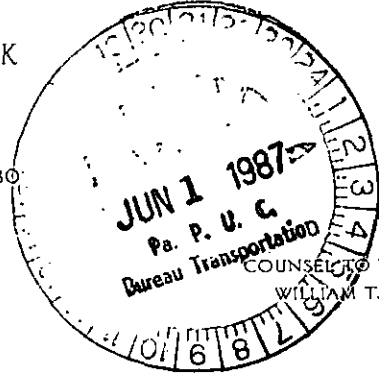

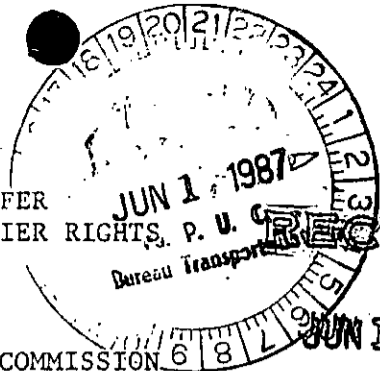



COMES NOW, the undersigned incorporator, in compliance with the requirements of Section 204 of the Business Corporation Law, Act of May 5, 1933 (P.L. 364) (15 P.S. §1204), desiring to be incorporated as a business corporation and hereby certifies as follows:

- (1) The name of the corporation is KLT, Inc..
- (2) The location of the initial registered office of the corporation in this Commonwealth is R. D. 3, Box 342, Bellefonte, Centre County, PA 16823. (14)
- (3) The corporation is incorporated under the Business Corporation Laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the following purpose or purposes:

The corporation shall have unlimited power to engage in and to do any lawful act concerning any or all lawful businesses for which corporations may be organized and incorporated under the Business Corporation Law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as amended, or any other statute or statutes now or in the future applicable to the corporation.

(4) The term for which the corporation is to exist is perpetual.

(5) The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is one hundred thousand (100,000) shares of common stock, having no par value.

(6) In addition to the one hundred thousand (100,000) shares of common stock, having no par value, which the corporation shall have authority to issue, the Board of Directors of the corporation shall be authorized to fix by a proper resolution the designations, preferences, qualifications, number and other pertinent provisions relative to specific classes or types of preferred stock.



THIS AGREEMENT, made this 16th day of April,
1987, by and between KENNETH L. TEAMAN, an individual, of R. D. 3,
Box 342, Bellefonte, PA 16823, referred to hereinafter as "Trans-

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, Transferor is the holder of certain motor carrier
operating authority as previously issued by the Pennsylvania Public
Utility Commission in Docket No. A-104857. Attached hereto as
Appendix A is a copy of the Order issued by the Pennsylvania Public
Utility Commission granting the said operating authority; and

WHEREAS, Transferee is an individual who desires to purchase a
portion of the said operating authority of Transferor; and

WHEREAS, the parties have entered into negotiations, by and
between themselves and through their representatives, for the sale

and purchase of a portion of the said operating authority held by Transferor, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement. Such authority is that set forth below, and a portion of that shown in Appendix A:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, used mobile homes and house trailers, from points in the county of Centre, to points in Pennsylvania and vice versa, provided that no right, power or privilege shall be granted authorizing service from points in Northumberland, Lycoming, Dauphin, Perry, Lancaster, Lebanon and Franklin Counties.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of their mutual covenants set forth herein, and with the intention of being legally bound, the parties hereunto agree as follows:

(1) The total purchase price of the operating authority herein shall be Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars.

(2) This Agreement shall be effective upon the signing of the within document, with the understanding that the full purchase price shall not be paid until final approval is gained from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission authorizing the full transfer of the operating authority.

(3) Full payment shall be made within fifteen (15) days of final approval of the transfer by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

(4) A transfer application will be filed as soon as reasonably possible after this Transfer Agreement is signed, with the understanding that rights and duties under this agreement as they relate to Transferee shall be assignable to an affiliated

corporation which Transferee anticipates forming.

(5) Approval of the transfer, by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, shall be deemed to occur and consummation shall be accomplished at the time an Order of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission is issued, served and received by counsel for Transferee, indicating that full and complete approval of the transfer rights has been accomplished.

(6) In the event that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission should refuse to transfer the authority in total, at the election of the Transferee, this Agreement may be declared null and void, or, once again at the election of Transferee, the parties shall have the right to negotiate a revised selling price, so as to reflect the change that has occurred in the authority that is being transferred.

(7) Transferor hereby warrants and covenants that he is authorized to enter into this Agreement and he holds the full operating authority in the documents attached hereto as Appendix A.

(8) Transferor further warrants that he will comply with all pertinent rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission during the pendency of a transfer proceeding that is filed relative to this matter.

(9) Transferor and Transferee hereby agree to take all reasonable steps necessary to properly obtain approval of the transfer of the said operating authority, such approval to be

obtained from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

(10) Transferor and Transferee hereby specifically authorize Dwight L. Koerber, Jr., Esquire, and Kriner, Koerber and Kirk, of 110 North Second Street, P. O. Box 1320, Clearfield, PA 16830, to sign all documents relative to the filing and implementation of an adoption tariff, and/or any other tariff document, as might be required by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission relative to this matter.

(11) Transferee and Transferor agree that they will share evenly the legal expenses associated with transferring the within operating authority, with Transferee also paying the filing fee in addition to his proportionate share..

(12) The parties hereby agree to expeditiously execute all appropriate documents, which, in the opinion of Dwight L. Koerber, Jr., Esquire, are proper and necessary in order to obtain final approval of the transfer of the said operating authority from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.


(13) It is agreed and understood that this Agreement shall be construed in accordance and under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.



O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 13, 1982, Ralph G. Lingle, Sr., t/a B&R Equipment & Supply Company (B&R) filed an application with the Commission at A-00101962 for amendment to its Certificate of Public Convenience so as to permit the transportation of new mobile homes and house trailers between specific points in central Pennsylvania.

In response to Protests, B&R restrictively amended its application so as to request the following two rights:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, new mobile homes and house trailers for Richard Kistler, t/d/b/a Summit Homes of Osceola Mills, from the borough of Osceola Mills, Clearfield County, to points in Pennsylvania and vice versa.

To transport, as a Class D carrier, used mobile homes and house trailers, from points in the counties of Centre and Clearfield, to points in Pennsylvania and vice versa, provided that no right, power or privilege shall be granted authorizing service from points in Northumberland, Lycoming, Dauphin, Perry, Lancaster, Lebanon and Franklin Counties.

On March 7, 1983, the Commission approved the application as amended. However, it appears that the ordering paragraphs of the March 7, 1983 Order inadvertently applied the condition prohibiting service from Northumberland, Lycoming, Dauphin, Perry, Lancaster, Lebanon, and Franklin Counties to the right to provide transportation for Summit Homes.

On May 20, 1983, Ralph G. Lingle, Jr. (Lingle), the present Petitioner, filed an application with the Commission for transfer to him of all of the operating rights held by B&R. By Order entered November 9, 1983, the Commission approved the transfer of all of the operating

rights held by B&R to Lingle at A-00104857. Again, the November 9, 1983 Order applied the condition prohibiting service from Northumberland, Lycoming, Dauphin, Perry, Lancaster, Lebanon and Franklin Counties to the right to provide service for Summit Homes.


On May 7, 1985, Lingle filed a Petition to Correct Certificate with the Commission. In its Petition, Lingle requests the Commission to amend his certificate in order to correct the administrative error in the March 7, 1983 Order granting B&R, the former Certificate holder, additional authority. Specifically, Petitioner requests that the condition prohibiting service in Northumberland, Lycoming, Dauphin, Perry, Lancaster, Lebanon and Franklin Counties be applied only to his third right (which authorizes service from Centre and Clearfield counties to points and Pennsylvania and vice versa) and not to his second right (which authorizes service for Summit Homes).

The record reflects that Petitioner is correct in his contention that the Commission's March 7, 1983 Order inadvertently applied a restrictive condition to B&R's right to provide service for Summit Homes and that this administrative error continued when the Commission granted transfer of B&R's rights to Lingle on November 9, 1983. Accordingly, Lingle's Petition has merit and should be granted; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Petition to Correct Certificate filed by Ralph G. Lingle, Jr. at A-00104857 is hereby granted.
2. That the Certificate of Public Convenience issued to Ralph G. Lingle, Jr. at A-00104857 be amended so as to remove the condition prohibiting service in Northumberland, Lycoming, Dauphin, Perry, Lancaster, Lebanon and Franklin Counties from right number 2 which authorizes service for Summit Homes.

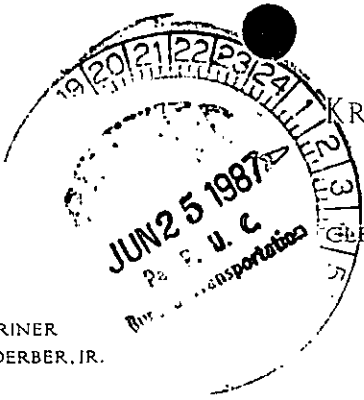
