Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

By Order entered April 2, 2011 ("Order"), the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") approved the Application of Shipley Choice, LLC ("Shipley Choice"), at Docket No. A-2010-2201675, to provide natural gas supplier services to residential, small commercial, large commercial, industrial and governmental customers in the service territories of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc., PECO Energy Company, UGI Central Penn Gas, Inc. and UGI Utilities, Inc. within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. In its Order, the Commission stated that if Shipley Choice seeks to serve customers in additional service territories in the future, it must notify the Commission Secretary by letter immediately to amend its license accordingly.

By this letter, Shipley would like to amend its authority to allow for the provision of service in the remaining service territories throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, namely, Valley Energy, Inc., Peoples TWP, LLC, UGI Penn Natural, Philadelphia Gas Works, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corp., Peoples Natural Gas Company, LLC, and Peoples Natural Gas Company, LLC, Equitable Division. Shipley Choice has published notice of this request in newspapers that cover the additional service territories as directed by the Commission. Proofs of Publication Affidavits from these newspapers are enclosed.

Also enclosed are letters from the various NGDCs into whose territory Shipley is seeking to expand demonstrating compliance with the bonding/credit requirements of the NGDCs.



We are pleased that ShIPLEY Energy has applied for a license to provide natural gas broker/marketer services on the Peoples Group of Companies. Specifically you have requested to be licensed as a supplier on the distribution systems of Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC, Peoples TWP, and Peoples Natural Gas LLC – Equitable Division (“the Companies”).

Since ShIPLEY Energy is not currently operating, and has no immediate plan to operate a Pool on the Peoples systems, we have determined at this time that ShIPLEY Energy does not need a bond or other financial security requirement to provide these services to the Company’s customers.

Dear Mr. Stetler,

UGI Utilities, Inc. ("UGIU") has reviewed the payment history and security information of Shipley Energy, LLC ("Shipley") associated with its existing operations in the UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division service territory. Based on this review and the requirement that Shipley must post security as specified in the UGI Penn Natural Gas ("PNG") Supplier Coordination Tariff before it serves customers on the PNG distribution system, UGIU has determined that Shipley has demonstrated adequate creditworthiness to satisfy any costs PNG may incur in the event it operates as a supplier of last resort due to a default on the part of Shipley.

This determination may change in the event there is a material deterioration in Shipley's financial condition, if Shipley's obligations to PNG exceed the amount of the financial security provided, if the financial security is withdrawn or is deemed to be null and void or inadequate due to the material financial deterioration of any guarantor, or if Shipley fails to abide by the terms and conditions of the PNG Gas Tariff and the PNG Natural Gas Supplier Coordination Tariff.

Philadelphia Gas Works ("PGW") is aware that Shipley Choice, LLC... has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas services to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the services territory of Philadelphia Gas Works.

As you know, in making such an application, Shipley Choice, LLC must furnish acceptable security to each utility where Shipley Choice, LLC. will do business. As such, under its tariff, Philadelphia Gas Works could require Shipley Choice, LLC. to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that Philadelphia Gas Works determines to be appropriate.

Dear Steve:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C. S. § 2208 (c), an applicant for a natural gas supplier license in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania must furnish security to each utility where the supplier will do business to ensure the financial responsibility of such natural gas supplier. To this end, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("National Fuel") will perform a credit review and analysis of Shipley Choice, LLC. ("Shipley Choice") and determine at the appropriate time whether Shipley Choice must post a security deposit acceptable to National Fuel, to operate as a supplier on National Fuel's system.

Shipley Choice's security requirement to serve Pennsylvania customers is dependent on the type of transportation service utilized by Shipley Choice. There is no Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) security requirement for customers that will be enrolled in National Fuel's Purchase of Receivable (POR) program. As such, Shipley Choice will not be required to post security for customers enrolled in the POR program. A security deposit will be required for transportation customers not enrolled in the POR program.

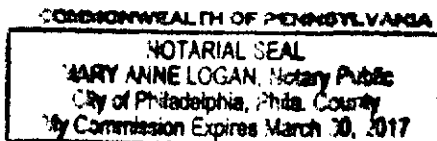


