

Gentlemen:

This is in response to your inquiry as to whether your new "Estimated Cost of Services" form is an acceptable document for your company to use in household goods service requests.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that we have identified three (3) problem areas contained in the document. The first problem is that the letters of the title of the document, "Estimated Cost of Services" are too small. The words "Estimated Cost of Services" shall be imprinted across the top of each form in letters not less than ½ inch high. Secondly, your "Estimated Cost of Services" form failed to specify/contain the following information: "Shipments of distances over 40 miles are estimated in weight and mileage". Finally, your "Estimated Cost of Services" form failed to specify/contain the information for a shipper, who would request insurance valuation of more than thirty cents (\$.30) per pound per shipment.

For your assistance, I am enclosing a copy of a "Estimated Cost of Services" form, which contains all the necessary information that we require by regulation.

Your "Estimated cost of Services" form, unfortunately, does not meet with the Commission's criteria. Therefore, you are directed to correct the problems/deficiencies with the form immediately. Failure to comply could result in monetary penalties and/or the cancellation of your certificate of public convenience.
