
5. This Agreement shall be contingent upon the approval by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and refusal of said transfer shall make this Agreement null and void.







SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT AND ORDER
MODIFYING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter being before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission upon application of JACOB A. JESSUP and WILLIAM J. JESSUP, copartners, trading and doing business as VALLEY TRANSFER COMPANY, dated August 31, 1960, for modification of the report and order issued under date of December 12, 1955, and the certificate of public convenience issued thereunder, as modified by supplemental report and order issued on June 24, 1957, and having been duly presented in accordance with the rules of the Commission, and full investigation of the matters and things involved having been had, and it appearing that the rights granted herein are in effect a transfer of the rights which have been held by BLANCK'S TRANSPORTATION COMPANY under report and order issued at A. 59284, Folder 2, on April 8, 1940 and the certificate of public convenience issued thereunder, as modified and amended by supplemental report and order issued on May 12, 1958, which report, order and certificate will be subsequently cancelled as of the date of this order upon compliance with the tariff requirements of the Commission by JACOB A. JESSUP and WILLIAM J. JESSUP, copartners, trading and doing business as VALLEY TRANSFER COMPANY, the Commission finds and determines that approval of the proposed modification is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation or convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

A Certificate of Public Convenience evidencing the Commission's approval of the right to operate will not be issued until the applicant has complied with the following insurance and tariff requirements:

- I. Arrange through an insurance agent to have an insurance company file the following forms with the Commission.
 - a. A Form E as evidence of minimum public liability and property damage insurance coverage as shown on the back of this sheet.





BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed August 1, 1988. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of August 20, 1988. The unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing.

The applicant, Allegheny Valley Transfer Company, is a Pennsylvania corporation, domiciled at 1512 Lebanon Church Road, Pittsburgh, Allegheny County. Jacob A. Jessup, president holds all of the outstanding stock. Howard A. Jessup is secretary-treasurer. An unaudited balance sheet shows total assets of \$289,039 with total liabilities of \$332,451, capitol stock and contributions of \$61,326 leaving a net loss of \$104,738 for the year 1987.

The total consideration for the rights is \$1.00. No tangible assets are involved. This is a conversion from a partnership to a corporation and the financial consideration is for a nominal sum.

A review of the record before us indicates that the applicant possesses the requisite experience, equipment and financial capacity to provide the proposed service.

The authority to be transferred has been operated by the transferor, therefore, it is presumed that there is a continuing public need, which may be overcome only by evidence to the contrary. In re: Byerly, 440 Pa. 521 (1970); Hostetter v. Pa. P.U.C., 160 Super. Ct. 94 (1947). Since the record is void of any such evidence, this presumption of continuing public need applies in this transfer proceeding.

We find:

1. The applicant is fit, willing and able to provide the service proposed.

2. That applicant shall not record in its utility accounts any amount representing the rights herein granted in excess of the actual cost of such rights to the original holder thereof.
3. That the applicant charge to Account 1550, Other Intangible Property, \$1.00, being the amount of the consideration payable by it for the rights and going concern value attributable thereto; less any amount recorded under condition 2 above; and subject to further adjustment due to any normal interim transactions to the date of actual transfer.
4. That the accounts of the transferee shall reflect the same book values as the records of the transferor at the effective date of the transfer, any previously recorded appreciation having been deleted therefrom; provided that the applicant shall not record in its utility accounts any amounts representing the rights herein granted in excess of the actual cost of such rights to the original holder thereof.
5. That the operating authority granted herein, or now held or subsequently granted to the applicant to the extent that it is duplicative shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.
6. That the certificate holder shall not transfer, sell or in any way convey any of its outstanding capital stock to any individual, partnership, corporation or any entity, without the prior filing of an application and approval thereof by the Commission under 66 PA C.S.A. §1102(a)(3).
