There are a few deficiencies which require your attention before the application is acceptable for filing:

1. We are enclosing a set of PUC 178 (Revised 11-86) to be used in the filing of this application, as we no longer use PUC 178.
2. We are enclosing a sample description using the Commission's usual common carrier phraseology, if it meets with your requirements initial and return with your application.
3. It is unusual for a limousine service to apply as a contract carrier. If you intend to apply as a contract carrier you will need to name the shipper(s).

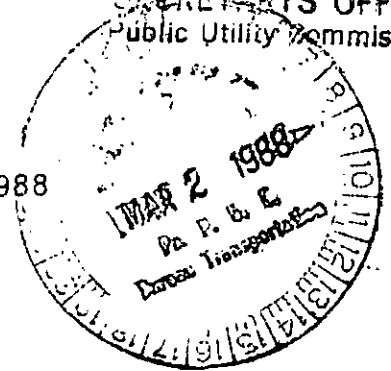
