Dear Ms. Chiavetta,

On March 31, 2014, I wrote to the Public utility Commission expressing concern about the unresolved billing issues related to the above case. Enclosed with that letter, I provided materials to substantiate the discrepancies and inaccuracies in monthly billing from 2009 to January, 2014. I also suggested an alternative means of resolving the ongoing dispute.

The concerns about billing and compensation have languished and a conclusion is long overdue. The lack of any response to my March communication convinces me that a new hearing before an Administrative Law Judge is necessary.

In its Opinion and Order on January 9, 2014, the PUC declared that "the Request to Reopen the Record filed by Larry Moyer on May 8, 2013, is granted for the limited purpose of further developing the record with regard to the bills and credits received by Mr. Moyer from PPL Electric Utilities Corporation." The same Opinion and Order stipulates that "Larry Moyer may request that the Office of Administrative Law Judge schedule further hearings".

I hereby request such Hearing(s) at the earliest possible date. I'm also requesting that the Hearing(s) be conducted by an Administrative Law Judge who has not previously been involved in the case.

The January Opinion and Order further stipulated that the request should "delineate *specific* errors in the bills, credits and payments rendered by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation". The materials which were part of the May 31 mailing (charts, narratives, etc.) delineated those errors as stipulated.





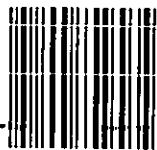
