PETITION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT

TO: PRESIDING ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE MARK A. HOYER:

Complainant Superior Tire & Rubber Corporation (Superior), by its counsel, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.94(a), hereby petitions for leave to withdraw its complaint in this proceeding, and represents as follows:

1. This matter is scheduled for telephonic hearing before Presiding Administrative Law Judge Mark A. Hoyer on October 14, 2014.
2. Superior seeks a refund in this case for rates charged by Hess Corporation during a portion of January 2014, during the so-called “Polar Vortex.”
3. Hess Corporation is an Electric Generation Supplier.
4. Superior filed its formal complaint without advice of counsel.
5. On advice of counsel, Superior now understands that the Commission lacks jurisdiction to provide refunds or otherwise adjust the rates billed to Superior by Hess.

WHEREFORE, Superior respectfully seeks leave to withdraw its complaint in this case.


