

4. On September 22, 2014 at approximately 3:30 p.m., the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement filed with the Secretary's Bureau and served on all parties timely Reply Exceptions.
5. However, the Reply Exceptions filed on September 22, 2014, did not contain a signature of I&E Prosecutor Allison C. Kaster.
6. On September 23, 2014 at approximately 7:56 a.m., I&E submitted the Reply Exceptions with the appropriate signature.
7. Except for the insertion of the necessary signature, the I&E Reply Exceptions filed on September 22, 2014 and September 23, 2014 are identical.
8. On October 10, 2014, I&E learned that its Reply Exceptions were deemed to be filed on September 23, 2014.
9. Commission Regulations require that Reply Exceptions be filed within ten (10) days of the date that the Exceptions are due. 52 Pa. Code § 5.535.
10. Timely Reply Exceptions in this proceeding were due on September 22, 2014.
11. The substantive rights of the parties were not affected by I&E filing Reply Exceptions on September 22, 2013 and then submitting the same Reply Exceptions on September 23, 2014 with the appropriate signature; therefore, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.2, I&E respectfully requests that the Commission waive the ten day reply period contained in its Regulations.

Wherefore, I&E respectfully request that the Commission grant the instant Petition and consider the merits of the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement's Reply Exceptions filed on September 23, 2014.
