



Q. AI-1. Reference *Utility Services Agreement for Goods Not Readily Available From the Market, Obsolete or Otherwise Surplus*, page2, #4, Compensation and Allocation. Please explain why PPL Energy is the only non-regulated party singled out for the pricing for goods transferred to and from the Regulated Parties. Do other non-regulated entities have the same requirement?

A. AI-1. Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of the *Utility Services Agreement for Goods Not Readily Available From the Market, Obsolete or Otherwise Surplus* ("Agreement"), the Regulated Parties, as defined in the Agreement, and PPL Energy may transfer to one another "goods not readily available." Pursuant to Paragraph 3 of the Agreement, the Regulated Parties and PPL Energy may transfer to one another "obsolete goods." The Agreement does not contemplate the transfer of these goods to or from any other entities, including any other non-regulated entities who are not parties to the Agreement. Accordingly, Paragraph 4 of the Agreement does not address the pricing of goods transferred to or from any entities other than the Regulated Parties and PPL Energy.
